This session made the student contemplate deeply by enriching their knowledge and interest towards the entrepreneurship and marketing.



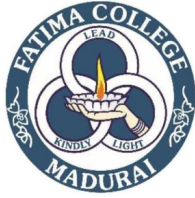

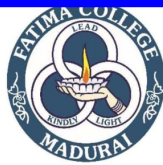

The Department of Physics organised a guest lecture on “Nuclear medicine“ on 18.08.2016. It was delivered by **Dr. K. Muthuvelu, Prof and Head, Department Of Radiology Physics, and Chief Medical Physicist, Barnard Institute of Radiology and Oncology, Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Madras Medical College, Chennai- 600 003** . He introduced the concept of Nuclear medicine as a **medical specialty** involving the application of **radioactive** substances in the diagnosis and treatment of **disease**. Nuclear medicine imaging, in a sense, is "**radiology** done inside out" or "**endoradiology**" because it records radiation emitting from within the body rather than **radiation** that is generated by external sources like **X-rays**. In addition, he also threw light on how nuclear medicine scans differ from radiology, as the emphasis is not on imaging anatomy, but on the function. For such reason, it is called a **physiological imaging modality**. He explained the basic principles of **Single photon emission computed tomography (SPECT)** and **positron emission tomography (PET)** scans which are the two most common imaging modalities in nuclear medicine.^[1] Around 129 of the students got benefitted out of it.
