INSTITUTE-INDUSTRY INTERFACE CELL

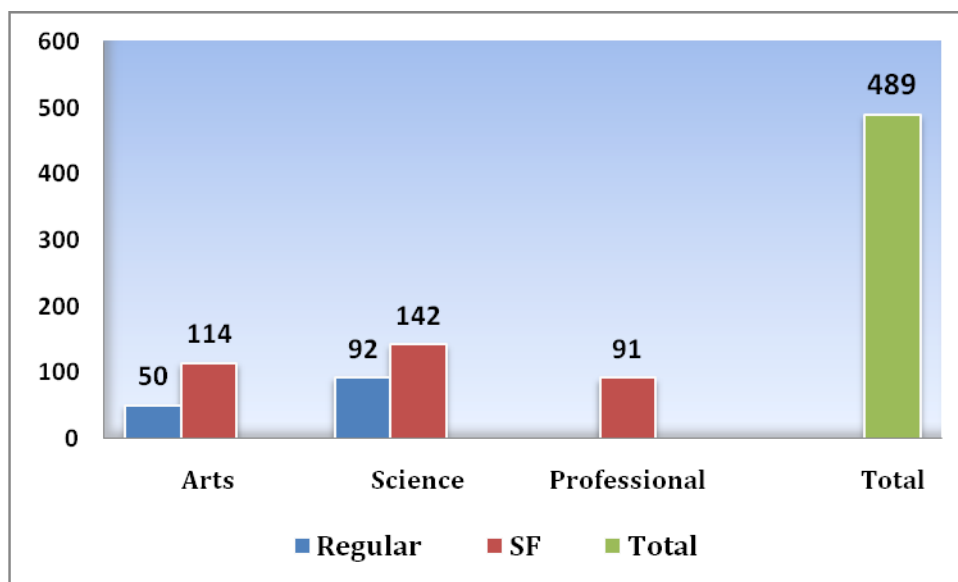

NET COACHING CENTRE
