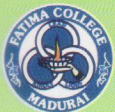

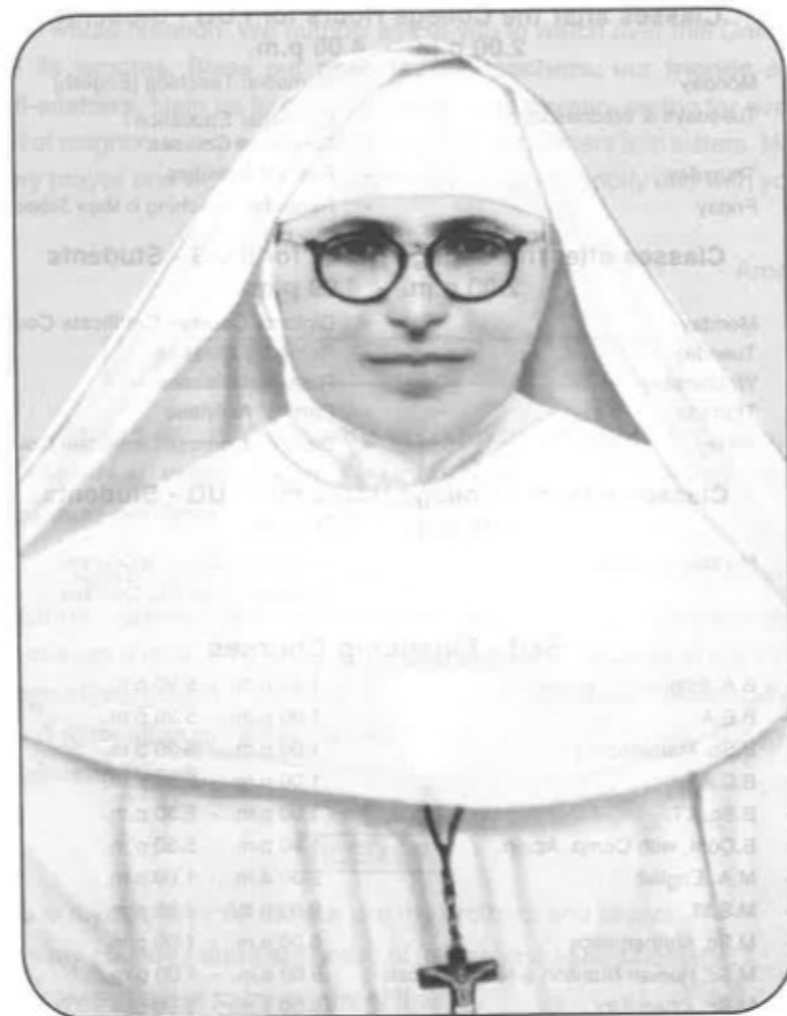

COLLEGE PROFILE

Fatima College, Mary Land, Madurai, is a Post Graduate College for women affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. It is a Catholic Minority institution established and run by St. Joseph's Society of Madurai (of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyons, France). This institution came into existence through the tireless efforts of the missionary sisters of St. Joseph of Lyons and the zeal and heroic sacrifice of Rev. Sr. Rose Benedicta, the Foundress of the College.

The College was started in St. Joseph's Campus Madurai as a Second Grade College with 63 students in 1953. The College was upgraded and became a Post Graduate College in 1964 and Autonomous in 1990. The College now offers 18 Under Graduate Courses, 14 Post Graduate Courses, 5 M.Phil. Courses and 4 Departments have become Research Centres. It has a strength of 4100 Students, 173 Teaching Staff and 95 Non-Teaching Staff.

The comprehensive assessment by NAAC in 1999 placed Fatima College in Five Star Status of merit. The College strives to sustain excellence, quality and relevance while equipping the students to meet the demands of higher education in India. In 2004 UGC conferred on Fatima College the status of **College with Potential for Excellence. In 2006 and 2013 NAAC Re-Accredited and honoured the college with 'A' Grade.**

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Fatima College has designed a Student-Centred Curriculum and introduced Choice Based Credit System which has provided the opportunity to make radical curricular modifications offering Inter Disciplinary Optional Papers / Subjects from one's own and other Departments, and Diploma / Certificate Courses for all students. The curriculum is designed to focus on a wholesome education that is Need Based, Value / Ethic Based, Job / Career Based and Research-based. Computer Based Papers are offered by all departments. In order to stimulate research skill, projects are made mandatory to the final year students. Hands on training through Internship and Exposure Programmes are offered by most departments. The General characteristic of change in syllabus is according to local relevance, Vocational Skills and Applied Aspects.

An English Attainment Test (EAT) to first years with Bridge Course followed by regular Remedial Teaching, three streams of English Course-Basic, Intermediate, Advanced and Spoken English Classes enhance the Communication Skills of the students. Apart from the Regular Curriculum, Value Education, Human Rights Education and Environmental Studies are also imparted.

The College has kept pace with the emerging trends in Information Technology by introducing programmes with Computer Applications (B.Sc. Computer Science, B.Sc.I.T., M.C.A, M.Sc. (IT&M), M.Sc. (CS&IT), Commerce with Computer Application, Sociology with Computer Application and a compulsory IT Foundation Course (for all Under Graduates). Post Graduate courses like M.A. Economics, M.Com. and M.Sc. Physics have introduced Computer Application Papers.

THE EXAMINATION SYSTEM

The two components of evaluation are Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for 25% marks and End Semester Examination (ESE) for 75% marks.

CIA

- The requisites for CIA are as follows:
 - Two centralized mandatory tests - Test 1 & Test 2
 - Quiz and
 - Assignment.
- Retest (with the Principal's permission) is conducted only for those students who are unable to attend either Test 1 or Test 2 due to unavoidable or unforeseen circumstances.

ESE

- Odd semester examinations are conducted in November and
- Even semester examinations are conducted in April.
- ESE question paper consists of
 - objective,
 - paragraph and
 - essay type questions.

Supplementary Exams

- Students can appear for
 - Odd semester papers during November ESE
 - Even semester papers during April ESE.
- Outgoing students with only one arrear paper to clear can appear for the same during April ESE.

Revaluation

- Failed candidates can apply for revaluation within 7 working days after the publication of results
- They should contact the college administrative office for
 - the application form and
 - details of fee for revaluation.
- The revaluation results will be published within 7 working days from the due date for the applications for revaluation.
- Revaluation results will be forwarded to the students' home address.

Private candidates

- Outgone students with arrears are considered as Private Candidates.
- Supplementary examinations in July are conducted only for Private candidates.

- During the July Supplementary examinations they can appear for any paper of the following semesters

- I to VI - U.G Courses
- I to IV - P.G Courses

- They are expected to bring their ID cards for the supplementary exams and for all sorts of enquiries.

CIA Improvement.

- Private candidates with marks less than the required aggregate pass minimum in the internals can improve the same by applying for CIA Improvement.
- They can apply in the college administrative office at the beginning of the respective semester.
- They should attend Test 1 and Test 2 along with the regular students, of the respective semester.

Malpractice

- Students indulging in malpractice during centralised internal tests or ESE will be severely punished.
- They have to face an enquiry committee with their parents.
- The enquiry committee comprises
 - Principal
 - Dean
 - HOD and
 - Controller of Examinations
- The enquiry committee will inform them of the nature of punishment that has been framed by the Examination committee.
- The following have been framed by the Examination committee:

• End semester Examination

- **First time offence** Cancellation of examination taken in the particular paper and debarring the candidate from appearing for that paper for one subsequent examination
- **Repeat offence** Cancellation of examination of all subjects registered for that session and debarring the candidate from appearing for these papers for one subsequent examination

• Centralized Tests

- First time offence - Cancellation of test in that paper and debarring the candidate from appearing for that paper in the retest.
- Repeat offence - Cancellation of tests in all the papers, debarring the candidate from appearing for tests in those papers for one subsequent semester.

- ❖ Courtesy, kindness, loyalty, dignity of labour, compassion for the less fortunate, a friendly attitude towards fellow-students, respect for teachers and authority are expected of every student of Fatima College.
- ❖ Students shall maintain silence and be attentive while attending classes, meetings of the college, associations and other gatherings.
- ❖ Students are not allowed to take their meals in the classrooms.
- ❖ Students are expected to conduct themselves in such a manner (whether inside the campus or outside) as to safeguard the dignity of womanhood and the good name of the college.
- ❖ Every new comer should be made to feel at home with a friendly and caring attitude.
- ❖ **Cell Phones are not permitted for students in the Hostel and in the College Campus.**

ECO-FRIENDLY CAMPUS:

Every student shall consider it as her personal responsibility to maintain cleanliness of the college. Every student shall strive to keep the classrooms and campus clean and eco-friendly. Effort is taken to make the campus "Plastic Free"

DRESS CODE :

- ❖ Students should wear clean, decent clothes and conform to the rules of modesty.
- ❖ Students are requested to wear Saree / Chudidhar with Dupatta. Modesty has to take priority over fashion.
- ❖ All students should have one set of **Perfect white Chudidhar with Dupatta.**

NOTICE BOARDS:

- ❖ Students shall **regularly** refer to the notice boards for the room allotments of their classes, test & exam timetables and other general information.
- ❖ No notice should be put up without the permission of the Principal.

FUND RAISING:

- ❖ No private collection of funds or sale of items can be made without the approval of the Principal.

ATTENDANCE:

- ❖ Regularity in attendance is obligatory in Fatima College.
- ❖ Candidates shall have 80% of minimum attendance per Semester to take the Semester Examination.
- ❖ Candidates who have less than 80% of attendance, but above 65% shall pay ₹ 50/- as per university rule, towards condonation fee.
- ❖ Those students who have less than 65% of attendance will have to repeat the Semester after completing the course.
- ❖ Students involved in Extra-curricular Activities shall contact the respective authorities who will seek the prior permission from the Principal (Warden in the case of resident students) for attendance.

LEAVE:

- ❖ Students should apply for leave only on the prescribed leave application appended to the College Calendar.
- ❖ In case of absence due to unforeseen cause, leave letter should be submitted to the class teacher on the first day of returning to the College.
- ❖ If leave is requested for reasons of sickness for more than two days, the leave application should be submitted along with the Medical Certificate.
- ❖ Continued absence without leave application will render a student liable to have her name struck off the rolls.

Please Note : submission of Leave Application with / without Medical Certificate does not entitle a student to earn attendance automatically for the days of her absence from the College.

SEMESTER FEES REGULATIONS:

In order to enhance the quality of institutional management, the academic year is divided into two Semesters and each Semester consists of a minimum of 90 working days without counting the test days and Exam days.

Semester fees shall be paid without fine within **10 working days and with fine within 30 days** from the date of reopening of each semester. Absence from College with or without leave will not be considered as an excuse for late payment.

If the Semester fees is not paid within 30 days after the re-opening the student's name shall be struck off the rolls of the college. If readmitted she shall pay a re-admission fee in addition to the fees and fine.

Every student shall pay the Semester fees due even if she discontinues before completing the Semester. If a student leaves the college during the Semester, she shall not have the right to claim a remission of any portion of the fees.

If a scholarship holder leaves the College during the Semester she will not get the scholarship even if the money is sanctioned, as it will be returned to the scholarship source.

NO DUES:

Clearance of attendance fees due is a prerequisite for :

1. Permission to write the Semester Exams.
2. Getting Transfer Certificate from the College.

CERTIFICATE:

- 1) A former or present student desiring to obtain a certificate (transfer, age, character, bonafide, etc) shall apply for it, by making a formal written request to the Principal.
- 2) A Certificate will not generally be issued in less than 24 hours notice.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

- ◆ On becoming a member of the College every one should accept the obligation to obey the rules and regulations of the College.
- ◆ **Indulging in any of the following will result in dismissal from the College.**
- ◆ Ragging of any sort or indulging in emotional violence inside the College/ Hostel Campus.
- ◆ Any kind of Malpractice (cheating, copying in tests and examinations, giving false declarations etc.) in the campus or anywhere else.
- ◆ Leaving the hostel without proper permission from the warden.

LIBRARY RULES:

ROSA MYSTICA LIBRARY

- ◆ Library is kept open from 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days and 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Saturdays.
- ◆ Students are allowed to enter the library with ID Card.
- ◆ U.G. students are given 10 books for 7 days.
- ◆ P.G. students are given 15 books for 14 days.
- ◆ M.Phil & Ph. D. students are given 20 books for 14 days.
- ◆ Staff are given 25 books for per semester.
- ◆ An overdue charge of ₹ 1/- per day.
- ◆ Books should be returned on the due stamped on the date sheet of each book.
- ◆ The borrower herself should bring the books to return to the library. Sub-lending of books is forbidden.
- ◆ Books removed from the library bookshelves should be left on the reading table.
- ◆ Students and faculties when leaving the college should obtain " NO DUE CERTIFICATE" from the Librarian.
- ◆ Reference books and Journals will not be issued, but are available for study within the Library.
- ◆ E-Materials (CD's DVD's and UVLC) are allowed to use within the campus only for the staff use.
- ◆ Check the pages of the book(s) before leaving the library counter. The last borrower will be held responsible for the missing page, scribbling, underlining and other damages in the book.
- ◆ Books removed from the library book shelves should be left on the reading table. Absolute silence shall be maintained inside the library. Combined study, discussions and consultations are strictly prohibited.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1) PG-SC, ST and Converted Christian SC Students are eligible for Fees concession. Those who wish to apply or renew Scholarship or Fees concession can have the application forms from the College Office. Duly filled in applications should reach the college office on or before 15th August, 2014.
- 2) Grant of Scholarship from the Government of India and State Government is admissible to the students only when sanction orders are issued by the appropriate authorities. The College is not responsible for the grant or non-grant of Government Scholarships. All Students are expected to pay their dues to the College till sanction orders are issued by the Government.
- 3) The Scholarship money will be disbursed to the students only after the money is actually paid by the government to the Principal and students have signed in the prescribed registers.
- 4) All money due to the College will be recovered from the scholarship amount at the time of disbursement. Intimation will be sent to parents and the balance amount if any, will be disbursed only after a reply is received from the government.

RESIDENT STUDENTS

- ◆ After any holiday, the Hostelites are expected to be in the campus, the evening prior to the reopening day.
