The research papers shall be in the standard research format, in the order of, abstract, key words, spelling out the need for study, objectives, hypothesis if any, methodology, techniques of data analysis, findings / results, conclusion, references and statistical tables. The submission should be in MS Word format only, typed in A4 single column format, 1.5 line spacing, using font Times New Roman, 12 point size and normal margins. Keep the layout of the text as simple as possible. References cited in the text should confirm to the style used by the American Psychological Association (APA). Name of the author/s their addresses (Postal and e-mail), and contact numbers should be given in the first page of the paper. A paper can have a maximum of two authors only.

PUBLICATION IN THE EDITED BOOK WITH ISBN NUMBER
