About the College

Fatima College (Autonomous), Mary Land, Madurai, is a Postgraduate College for women affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. It is a Catholic Minority institution established and run by St. Joseph's Society of Madurai (of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyons, France). This institution came into existence through the tireless efforts of the missionary sisters of St. Joseph of Lyons and the zeal and heroic sacrifice of Rev.Sr. Rose Benedicta, the Foundress of the College.

The College was started with 63 students in 1953. It was upgraded and became a Postgraduate College in 1964 and autonomous in 1990. The College now offers 20 Undergraduate courses, 14 Postgraduate courses, 2 Professional courses, 5 M.Phil. courses and 6 departments have become Research Centres. It has 4510 students, 214 Teaching Staff and 95 Non-Teaching Staff.

About the Workshop

Therefore, it is the need of the hour for the higher education teachers to acquire skills on developing e-learning resources and to arrive at strategies and tools that would ensure effective student engagement and capacity building for global competency of the students.

- have gained knowledge of Digital learning tools like software, computer and mobile applications in order to facilitate MOOCs and flipped classrooms
- have received hands on experience in preparing teaching learning material to suit the unique needs of the respective Institutions and students
