## Conduct of Examination & Evaluation

In accordance with the Government Instructions G.O (M.S) No. 505 dtd. 19.09.2020, the End Semester Examinations were conducted through Online/Blended mode. Question Papers were sent to the students through Google Classroom at 8.30 a.m & 12.30 p.m respectively for the F.N and A.N Sessions on the scheduled days of the exams. Instantly, the students acknowledged the receipt of the question paper. The students wrote their exams in two sessions from 9.00 a.m - 12.00 noon (F.N) and 1.00 p.m to 4.00 p.m (A.N). Soon after their exams, the student uploaded their answer sheets in the respective Google classrooms within an hour of completion. The class teachers ensured the receipt of all the answer scripts.

The soft copies of the answer scripts were sent to the course teachers for single valuation. The valuation was completed within 3 days.

## Marks Verification

Internal marks were sent to the students on June 23 and 24, 2021 for verification and were asked to report discrepancies if any on or before June 28, 2021. The staff verified the computed internal and external marks on July 5, 2021. The Results were published on July 7, 2021 through Google Meet.

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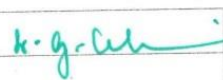
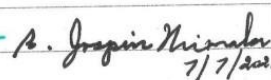
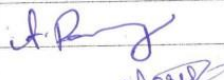
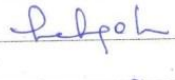
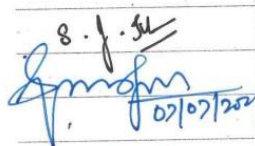
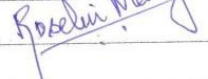
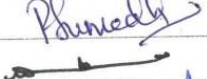
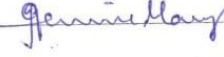
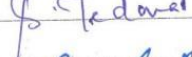
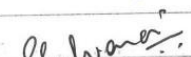
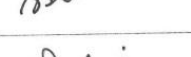
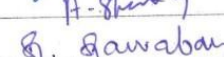
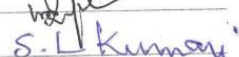
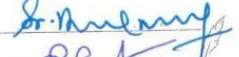
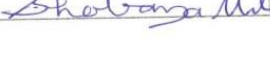
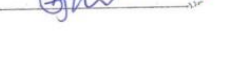
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- Dr. N. Shankar proposed that the printed records could have the year, course, course code and the major.
