Vigilance foundation is psychiatric care cum de-addiction centre. The vigilance foundation is located in Naagamalaipudukottai, Madurai. Their main motto is "a guard to your recovery". It was started in the year 2018. The vigilance foundation is registered with govt. of India, and to be licensed by IMH, under mental health care act 2017.

In his speech he explained that addiction is a continuous action or behaviour despite the adverse consequences in all the areas of our life such as physical, mental, relationship, finance, job, health, social and spiritual. Addiction is nothing but an obsession and compulsion towards an action or behaviour. He also shared the functions of Vigilance foundation. Also he explained about the difficulties faced by patients in order to overcome the addiction. He said that sudden stop in the intake of those substances leads to various problems in body as well as in mind.

Thus, this session helped the students to know more about the addiction and the activities which takes place at vigilance foundation.

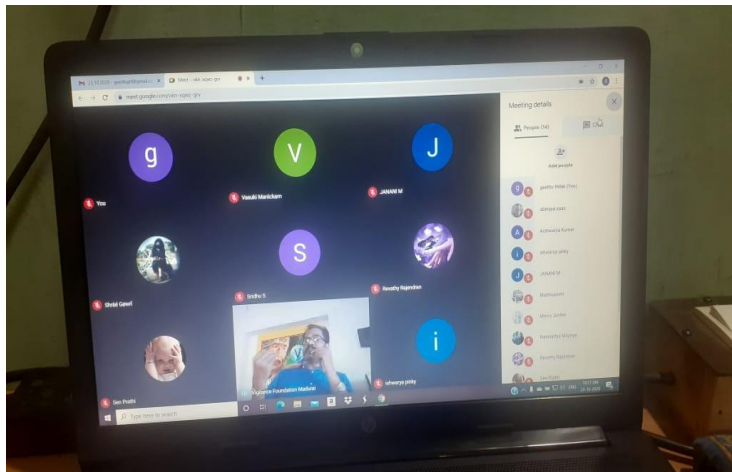
