- 1. Information about the company (By reading newspapers)
- 2. Comparison of skills and job requirements
- 3. To prepare responses to few likely asked questions like your strengths, weaknesses, accomplishments, goals, etc.




Topic: Training on Self Esteem Date: 06.01.2021


