

#### REPORT

# WEBINAR ON NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY 2020 (NEP) ORGANIZED BY IQAC A REPORT 06.11.2020

The guest speaker of the day was Dr. Karthikeyan, Dean and Controller of Examinations, Vivekananda College, Madurai. The speaker began his speech by focusing on the new system that is brought in the education sector. He highlighted the transformation from CBCS way of teaching to OBE Pattern.




