The World Tourism Organization defines tourism more generally, in terms which go "beyond the common perception of tourism as being limited to holiday activity only", as people "traveling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year for leisure and not less than 24 hours, business and other purposes".

Tourism comprises the activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than 12 consecutive months for leisure, business and other purposes. 



GANDHI MEMORAIL MUSEUM INTERNSHIP REPORT 2022

The present Gandhi Memorial Museum of Madurai is a historical building. It used to be the palace of Rani Mangammal from Naick dynasty. Known as Tamukkam Palace, it was built around 1670 A.D. Spread over an area of 13 acres, this palace presents an example of architectural fineness, which allures every visitor.

However, later this palace came under rulers of other dynasties and also East India Company during the colonial era. It used to be the official residence for the British District Collector of Madurai. It was in 1955, when this palace was gifted to All India Gandhi Smarak Nidhi by the Tamil Nadu State Government. It was done with the purpose of creating a Gandhi Memorial Museum in Madurai. This museum was built by Gandhi Smarak Nidhi and is maintained by the same. It was inaugurated in the year of 1959 by Jawaharlal Nehru.

The Campus

Gandhi Memorial Museum not only boasts of a rich collection but also presents an alluring architecture. Once a palace named Tamukkam belonging to Rani Mangammal during Naick reign, this building is a beautiful structure which is worth admiring.

In front of the main building of Gandhi Memorial Museum, you can see a hut, named Gandhi kutir. It is located slightly towards the south of the main building. It has been created as a replica of the original hut of Mahatma Gandhi in Sevagram. The ground floor of the building has a section of Khadi and Village Industries where you can see various village industries which were revived by Mahatma Gandhi. On the northern side of the building, there is a library with more than 20,000 volumes. Here one can find around 2, 70, 000 letters of Mahatma Gandhi and many reels of microfilms. There is an open air theatre as well. It is situated to the south of the main building of the museum. This vast open air theatre has a capacity to accommodate around 8000 people.

Various cultural programs, public meetings and shows are organised at this theatre on regular basis. To the northern side of the building, there is a newly created wing which houses a

library as well.

Relics and Replicas at Gandhi Memorial Museum, Madurai

One of the most interesting sections of the museum, this part showcases around 100 artifacts which were used by Mahatma Gandhi, including a blood stained cloth which was used by him on the day of his assassination. This piece of cloth, which is said to be a replica of the original cloth, has been preserved carefully in a glass box. Other relics at this section include a letter written by Mahatma Gandhi to Adolf Hitler in which he has address Hitler as a 'dear friend'; a letter personally written by him to Narayanan Satsangi of Devakottai along with a congratulatory letter by Mahatma Gandhi to Subramania Bharati, who was also a great poet and a freedom fighter.

- Role of women freedom fighters, etc.,


Mr.R.Natarajan also taught role of Mahatma Gandhi for the India's harmony after the independence era as well.







Tourism is travel for pleasure or business; also, the theory and practice of touring, the business of attracting, accommodating, and entertaining tourists, and the business of operating tours. The World Tourism Organization defines tourism more generally, in terms which go "beyond the common perception of tourism as being limited to holiday activity only", as people "traveling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year for leisure and not less than 24 hours, business and other purposes".

Tourism comprises the activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than 12 consecutive months for leisure, business and other purposes. Tourism comprises the activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year (12 months) for leisure, business or other purposes. This includes goods and services the tourist pays for personally or somebody pays for on his/her behalf, or which the tourists receive without compensation f or his/her own use or to be given to someone else. Included are expenses paid before the trip or after it. Tourism does not include international transport of tourists, which is included in passenger transports of transport services.

Tourism can be domestic (within the traveller's own country) or international, and international tourism has both incoming and outgoing implications on a country's balance of payments. Tourism is considered to be an important aspect of economic growth and the development of a nation. According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO), global tourism is expected to reach 1.6 billion (in terms of international arrivals) by the year 2022. Tourism management is generally considered a bright and potential employment sector as it offers a wide variety of career opportunities in both the private and public sector.

Tourism Management

Tourism Management involves the management of multitude of activities such as studying tour destination, planning the tour, making travel arrangements and providing accommodation. It also involves marketing efforts to attract tourists to travel to pardicular destinations.

In this Day sir explained about the 6 days Package (e.g. Madurai to Ooty)





GANDHI MEMORAIL MUSEUM INTERNSHIP REPORT 2022

The present Gandhi Memorial Museum of Madurai is a historical building. It used to be the palace of Rani Mangammal from Naick dynasty. Known as Tamukkam Palace, it was built around 1670 A.D. Spread over an area of 13 acres, this palace presents an example of architectural fineness, which allures every visitor.

However, later this palace came under rulers of other dynasties and also East India Company during the colonial era. It used to be the official residence for the British District Collector of Madurai. It was in 1955, when this palace was gifted to All India Gandhi Smarak Nidhi by the Tamil Nadu State Government. It was done with the purpose of creating a Gandhi Memorial Museum in Madurai. This museum was built by Gandhi Smarak Nidhi and is maintained by the same. It was inaugurated in the year of 1959 by Jawaharlal Nehru.

The Campus

Gandhi Memorial Museum not only boasts of a rich collection but also presents an alluring architecture. Once a palace named Tamukkam belonging to Rani Mangammal during Naick reign, this building is a beautiful structure which is worth admiring.

In front of the main building of Gandhi Memorial Museum, you can see a hut, named Gandhi kutir. It is located slightly towards the south of the main building. It has been created as a replica of the original hut of Mahatma Gandhi in Sevagram. The ground floor of the building has a section of Khadi and Village Industries where you can see various village industries which were revived by Mahatma Gandhi. On the northern side of the building, there is a library with more than 20,000 volumes. Here one can find around 2, 70, 000 letters of Mahatma Gandhi and many reels of microfilms. There is an open air theatre as well. It is situated to the south of the main building of the museum. This vast open air theatre has a capacity to accommodate around 8000 people.

Various cultural programs, public meetings and shows are organised at this theatre on regular basis. To the northern side of the building, there is a newly created wing which houses a

library as well.

Relics and Replicas at Gandhi Memorial Museum, Madurai

One of the most interesting sections of the museum, this part showcases around 100 artifacts which were used by Mahatma Gandhi, including a blood stained cloth which was used by him on the day of his assassination. This piece of cloth, which is said to be a replica of the original cloth, has been preserved carefully in a glass box. Other relics at this section include a letter written by Mahatma Gandhi to Adolf Hitler in which he has address Hitler as a 'dear friend'; a letter personally written by him to Narayanan Satsangi of Devakottai along with a congratulatory letter by Mahatma Gandhi to Subramania Bharati, who was also a great poet and a freedom fighter.

- v. Commerce without morality
- vi. Science without Humanity
- vii. Worship without sacrifice

DAY:14-20

Mr.R.Natarajan explained about Gandhi's visit to Madurai for next one week. They are as follows;

♦ March 26 – 28th 1919

To enroll volunteers for Satyagraha in connection with Rowlatt Act

❖ September 20 – 22, 1921

Gandhi visited for the first time to adopt the lion cloth here in Madurai at 2.51 A.M in the West Nasu street

❖ September 28-30th, 1927

To collect funds for Khadi and spreading the message of Swadeshi

❖ January 25-27th, 1934

 $During\ his\ All-India\ Harijan\ Tour,\ with\ Takkar\ Bapa\ and\ Mira\ Rehin$

❖ February 2-3rd, 1946

Worshipped in sree meenakshi temple which was thrown open to the Harijans earlier.

DAY:21-25

For the next one week Mr.R.Natarajan taught us Mahatma Gandhi's contribution to India's independence. Viz.,

- Partition and communal riots, cabinet mission's participation, cabinet mission
 contribution, violent national monuments, Indian national army, quit India
 movement, the removal of untouchabity, civil disobedience movement, no
 changes and pro changes movements.
- Jaliian wallabagh massacre, beginning of people's participation, extremists's differences of opinion
- Role of women freedom fighters, etc.,

Mr.R.Natarajan also taught role of Mahatma Gandhi for the India's harmony after the independence era as well.

DAY:27&28

The last week of my internship programme, We had been taught about the Museum maintenance, library arrangements, separation of rare books collections, cards tagging etc., I successfully completed my Gandhi memorial museum training programme. I had learned many useful skills and techniques in this internship programme, thanks to the Fatima College for had been provided this valuable opportunity and also I express my thankfulness and the gratitude to Gandhi Memorial Museum for the opportunity and the knowledge.
