Report On Case Study Analysis

As a part of the MBA curriculum, case study method involves presenting students with case studies, also known as cases that document a real-life business situation or imagined business scenario. MBA students learn how to analyze business problems and develop solutions from a leadership perspective. Students are asked to read the case, analyze the problems that are presented, evaluate underlying issues, and present solutions that address the problem that was presented. The analysis should include a realistic solution as well as an explanation as to why this solution is the best fit for the problem and the organization's goal. The reasoning should be supported with evidence that has outside been gathered through research. Finally, analysis should include specific strategies for accomplishing the solution proposed.

Case study analysis method imparts ability to the students to identify the root cause of problems, problem-solving skills, and negotiation skills.
