"The Madayar community people also called as Karuppar whose profession was to open and maintain the Dams and Tanks even during the time of floods. After their rewarding sacrifice, they will be worshipped as a God of tanks and dams" said by Mr.Elamuhil the speaker. The speaker acquainted with several facts about three rivers; Vurudhammal, Sathaiyaru and Vaigai in Madurai and its traditional and cultural significance. The connection of these rivers and festivals with Alagar festivals were significant one. The literary references about these rivers and its cultural and religious ceremonies were highly informative and interesting as well.

Moreover, people of Tirunelveli have very close contact with the river in terms of cultural and other river celebrations than Vaigai. Hence, there is more number of volunteer organizations involved. 


