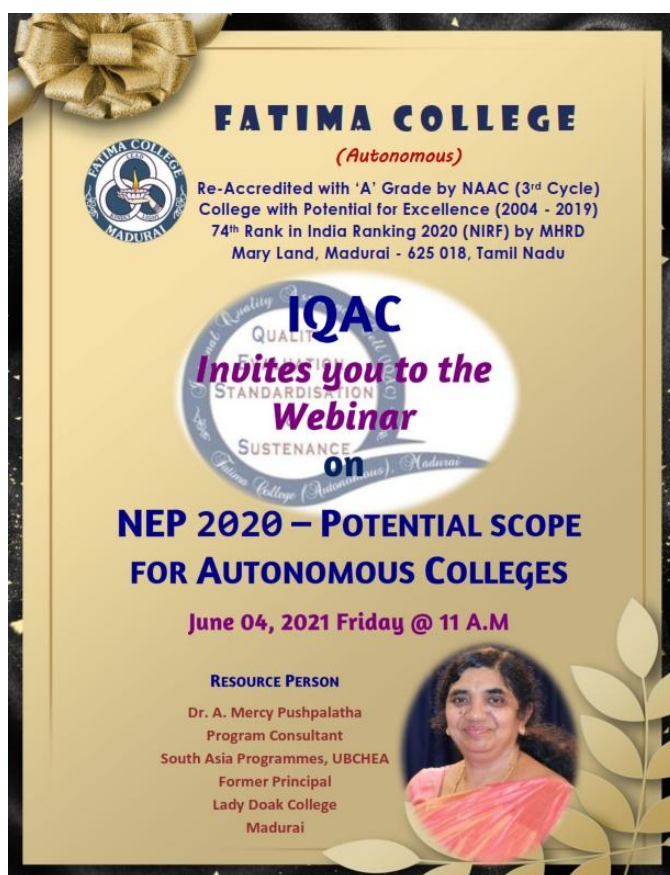

The IQAC of Fatima College organized a Webinar on "**NEP 2020 - Potential Scope for Autonomous Colleges**" on **June 4, 2021** for all the teaching faculty of Fatima College. Dr Magdalene Abraham, Assistant Coordinator of IQAC & Associate Professor of the Research Centre of English welcomed the participants. Dr. G. Celine Sahaya Mary, Principal, introduced the resource person Dr. A. Mercy Pushpalatha, Program Consultant, South Asia Programmes, UBCHEA & former Principal, Lady Doak College, Madurai.

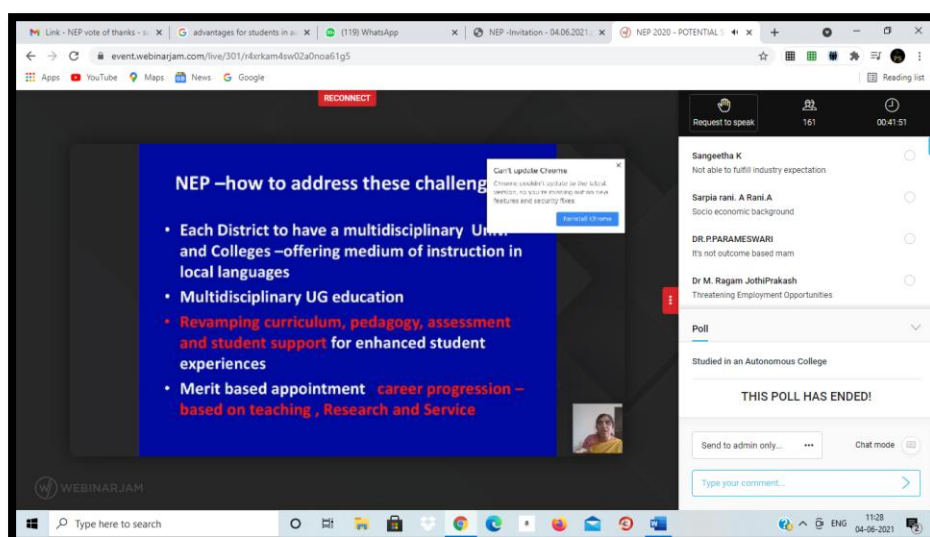


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The resource person began the session by stating that the National Education Policy 2020 proposes a paradigm shift in the teaching learning pedagogy in all institutes of higher education.
