

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Fatima College organized a Capacity Building Programme for the non-teaching staff on 14.12.2021 at Smart Room from 2 to 4 pm. The Resource Person of the programme was Dr. M. Meena Kumari, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Sociology and Social Work. Thirty two non-teaching staff attended the programme and benefitted.

The programme started with a prayer song by Ms. V. Ebenezar Vimala Rani. Dr. S Saira Banu, Assistant Coordinator of the IQAC, welcomed the gathering and introduced the Resource Person who had received Best Teacher and Young Woman Scientist Awards. Dr. M. Meena Kumari started her inspiring speech after the Welcome Address.

Dr. M. Meena Kumari cited writer Jeyagandhan's concept of beauty from his work *Agraharathu Poove* and pointed out the individual 'beauty' in non-teaching staff. By comparing the participants with the root of the tree, she acknowledged their tremendous yet hidden contribution to the growth of any institution. Then, pointing out to the death of the famous singer & dancer Michael Jackson, she mentioned how depression could be dangerous leading to death. In order to review oneself periodically, she urged them to ask questions to themselves for assuring mental health:

- 1. Do I sleep too much?
- 2. Do I have loss of appetite/more appetite?
- 3. Am I unstable emotionally?
- 4. Do I have fear unnecessarily?
- 5. Has my attention level come down?

The positive response to these questions refer to environment oriented depression. There were other realms causing impact, she said. They were:

- Family &
- Individual

Concentrating on the first, Work, the Resource person highlighted the services rendered by the Founder of Fatima College Mother Rose and said that we are gifted to work in an institution built by the vision of such great personality. She specified how Fatima College functions as a family and not merely as an institution. She also underscored the belongingness every staff has towards our institution.


