Abstract

According to the classification proposed in the previous publication by Kluge, the genus *Teloganodes* Eaton 1882 is divided into three subgenera distinguished only by tergalii number: the subgenus *Teloganodes* (with 5 pairs of tergalii on uromeres II–VI), the subgenus *Dudgeodes* Sartori in Sartori *et al.* 2008 (with 4 pairs of tergalii on uromeres II–V) and the subgenus *Derlethina* Sartori in Sartori *et al.* 2008 (with 3 pairs of tergalii on uromeres II–IV).
