





REPORT:

We the students of III BA ECONOMICS attended the "GRAM SABHA MEETING" on 15th of August; celebrating the 75th Independence of India from 10:00 am – 12:00 pm.

- 1. The officer in charge started reading the information regarding Agriculture and other related information. The officer included that the marginal farmers, women working in the field could get the modern technologies at the cost of 70% and other farmers could get that machines and tools at the cost of 50% provided by the Central Government of India.
- 2. JAL JEEVAN MISSION To provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections by 2024 to all households in rural India. The vision of this scheme is that every rural household has drinking water supply in adequate quantity by mobilizing financial assistance to states/UTs for implementation of the mission
- 3. Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act(MGNREGA) –This programme provides 100 days assured employment every year to every households. One-third of the proposed job is fixed for women. It is reported that nearly 3% of rural people in Thenkarai got their job under this proposed act till 31.07.2022.
- 4. Banning of plastics The GOI together with the TN Government banned the one time use plastics all over the state especially in rural areas. The use of plastic bags, bottles, flags is banned and those who

store and supply the plastics and other related products are prohibited and severe actions will be taken.

- 5. Funding to rural poor Funds were allocated to the rural poor under various schemes like MGNREGA, PMRH, etc. were provided. Circulars were passed and submitting the statistics to the Panchayat head and acknowledging with the people in village.
- 6. Creating awareness on rain water conservation Ahead of North East monsoon, the farmers must make sure of saving the rain water in lakes and ponds. Ploughing the field before the rain for the sufficient use of rain water without any blockages.
- 7. HarGharTirang The PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA, Shri. Narendra Modi announced the harghartirang. He proposed that every people living in India can hoist our INDIAN TRICOLOR FLAG from 13-15th of AUGUST ahead of our 75th INDEPENDENCE DAY.
- 8. Health and sanitation The Government of Tamil Nadu from 15 August, 2022 to 2 October, 2022 have initiated the health and sanitation programme for every rural people. Creating awareness on public toilets, cleaning their surroundings, etc.



We the students observed the gram sabha meeting. The people in the meeting spoke about their problems frankly with freedom. In ward 7, Thiruvedagam health centre, the infrastructure of the health centre was not proper and it contains lot of holes which is threatening. They asked to close the holes using bricks inorder to get a permanent solution. Then they talked about the road facilities in which the stones in the roadside are not proper, because of this, the rainwater gets stagnated here and there and hence there emerges quarrel. They said that their drainage system was not up to the mark and suggested that some action has to be taken. Water facilities and electricity was also a problem. They discussed about water management. They also asked to equip RO water facilities in front of the temple. They asked to give some solutions for the above mentioned. Then they said that in ward 3, there is no water and the population has also increased. At first there was a 30,000 litre tank and now they are demanding a 40,000 litre tank. They requested bathroom facilities also. They said that




