

Report

One-day Exhibition on the Cultural Heritage of Tamil Nadu -Tracing the Roots of Tamil Culture was organized by The Department of History Fatima College in Collaboration with The DHAN Academy(TDA)&DHAN Foundation conducted on 26.10.2022 in Jubilee Hall, Fatima College, Madurai.

One Hundred and Fifty Five students from the Department of History of Fatima College, two hundred and twenty other department staff &students from Fatima College, three staff from DHAN including two chief guests, five students from DHAN Academy, and Three rural Community people from Vikramangalam Village, Madurai participated in this One Day Exhibition on Cultural Heritage of Tamil Nadu – Tracing the Roots of Tamils.

Principal Dr. Sr. G. Celine Sahaya Mary addressed the gathering and gave an Inaugural speech. First of all, Sister Principal appreciated and encouraged the department staff members and the Head of the Department madam for arranging such a useful program. Special mention was recorded to highlight Dr.B.Poornima Sethupathi Assistant Professor, Department of History the then coordinator of the program for having worked so hard and sincerely and following the program keenly in every nuance of the program. Sister also appreciated history department students for their sincerity and hard work not just for this exhibition but also for their involvement and successes in the recent outside competitions.

Dr.V.Vedachalam, the Archaeologist and Senior Epigraphist addressed the gathering and gave a keynote address. The speaker, first of all, appreciated the history department students for all their handcrafts on various traditional and cultural models' preparations. Dr.V.Vedachalam briefed the historical legacy of Madurai and its rich tradition and heritage. Special mention was recorded for the Inscriptions of Pandya Nadu. Madurai being an ancient city possessing an abundance of historical and heritage

monuments has lots of scope not just to gain knowledge but also to get awareness to conserve and preserve. "All the models done by students resemble the most realistic", said the Speaker Dr.V.Vedachalam.

After the keynote address, the chief guests, and staff members of the Department of History and DHAN foundation started to visit the exhibition sport – displays. It was an interesting moment and a great knowledge-sharing moment by chief guests, sister principal, staff members, and guest participants from DHAN. The mindful exhibition included many segments primarily displaying old antiquities. The antiquities collections included Mulaipparikottu, old Vetrilaippatti, old Silambu etc., many clay models and miniatures of traditional ornaments, games, models depicting 5 types of *Thinai* etc.,

Various styles of Indian Architecture were modelled with detailed descriptions. The most interesting models were Chettinad architecture, cave temples like Sittannnavasal cave temple, and many other Hindu temples, mosques, and Churches.

The recreation of artifacts and antiquities excavated from Keezhadiexcavation was the main attraction for the viewers. Sister Principal especially appreciated the replica of the Keezhadi model.

As a part of the cultural and religious practices of the Tamils, the *Golu*(festival of Navratri)was greatly appreciated by both Principal and the Chief guests. Given the Rural tourism, models like typical village scenes which include bullocks and agricultural lands, etc., were also beautifully portrayed through models.

An Audio-Visual –Documentary movie entitled Traditions of Tamil Nadu which never ends and a few other short films done by History department students and DHAN Academy students were played in the background for further entertainment of the audience.

Many healthy and tasty traditional food items like; *Aval urundai*, *Arisiouttu, Kollusundal*, etc., prepared by History department students were kept on the display, which was tasted by the Chief Guests and the Principal sister. Food items like Tinaipayasam, Karupuulundhu idly Kelvarahukilukattai, and a few other items were prepared and displayed by the Community - people who were also a part of this exhibition. It was also tasted by the Guests.

Many pencil sketches, albums of the thematic history of Pandyas, Keezhadi antiquities, and realistic miniatures of Vandiyur Mariyamman temple were recreated. Different kinds of Art forms were displayed including; Cheriyal paintings, Phad paintings, Tanjore paintings, and Kalamkari paintings. Students also eagerly displayed the instruments used for making those art forms for example kalam pencil used for kalamkari painting, block prints used for Machnipattinam art form, and earthen pot painting depicting 5 Tinais.

The second part - the valedictory function was started by 2 pm after the lunch break. A cultural performance like Bharatnatyam, folk song group singing, and awareness skit was done by students of the History department. Followed by a welcome address for the chief guest Mr.Nellai Bharathi, the founder of Yuva Kendra was given by Dr.J.Sarah Evangelin, the Head of the Department, Department of History, Fatima College. Madam after briefing the profile of the resource person, recorded special thanks for sponsoring certificates and lunch for this programme freely. Appreciated and encouraged the students for their marvelous exhibition of various models.
