The Students presented the following grievances:

- \* Shift II Students represented that sometimes there is no water in the WEAT block rest room
- \* Students of Fashion Designing Diploma course represented their grievance that the Computers in their lab were not updated and some of the computers have lost the display quality
- \* Some of the students have complained about the quality of food in the canteen
- \* Some of the students expressed their difficulty to pay the fees on time and hence requested extension of time. Also few students requested for concession

After listening to the students' grievance, Dr. Dr. G. Celina Sahaya Mary, Principal addressed the students and the following redressal measures were taken:

- \* Water scarcity in the rest room of the WEAT block were taken care by filling the water tank multiple times in a day
- \* The Fashion Designing Diploma course lab was equipped with new systems.
- \* The quality of food were ensured by having discussion with the canteen contractor regarding the improvement in the quality of food.
- \* The date to pay the fees was extended and provided concession to the needy students as per the usual practice of the college. This year 96 students were given the concession.
