

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#### **REPORT:**

The Department of MBA organised a guest lecture on the topic "Managing Stress in Professional Life", felicitated by the resource person Dr. R. Vetrickarthick, Department of Gandhian Thought and Peace Science, The Gandhian Rural Institute (Deemed to be University), Dindigul. The event was held at Sanjose seminar hall from 1:30 p.m to 2:30 p.m on 16th February, 2024. 89 students of I MBA and 86 students of II MBA attended the session.

#### **Highlights:**

The programme began with the welcome address delivered by Ms. Shuruthi of I MBA. The guest lecture focused on the importance of maintaining a healthy work-life balance, overcoming monophobia, finding inner peace, and prioritising good health in order to effectively manage stress in a professional setting.

The speaker began by discussing the concept of work-life balance and its significance in preventing burnout and maintaining overall well-being. He emphasised the importance of setting boundaries between work and personal life, and finding time for self-care activities and hobbies outside of work. The speaker highlighted that creating a balance between work and personal life is essential for reducing stress and increasing productivity in the workplace. The session brought up the issue of monophobia, or the fear of being alone. They explained that many professionals struggle with feeling isolated or lonely, especially in high-stress environments. Strategies for overcoming monophobia, such as seeking support from friends and family, building a strong social network, and engaging in social activities outside of work was highlighted. The speaker also discussed the importance of finding inner peace amidst the chaos of professional life. He encouraged attendees to prioritise their mental and emotional well-being in order to navigate the challenges of a demanding work environment. Lastly, the speaker highlighted the connection between good health and stress management. They discussed the impact of stress on physical health and well-being, and emphasised the importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle through regular exercise, proper nutrition, and adequate sleep. The speaker encouraged attendees to prioritise their health in order to better cope with stress and improve overall quality of life.

Overall, the guest lecture on managing stress in professional life provided attendees with valuable insights and practical strategies for navigating the pressures of a demanding work environment. Attendees left the lecture feeling inspired and motivated to implement these strategies in their own lives. The session ended with a vote of thanks which was delivered to the speaker by Ms. Rithani of I MBA, for acquainting the students with a refined and value-filled session.
