EXPLORIA'24 – An Intercollegiate Research competition was organized by the Research and Development cell of Fatima College on 22-02-2024 at 9.00 am, to enhance the research culture among college students and develop analytic skills of the students in their respective discipline. It was conducted on the theme "Innovate to Bridge the Gap between / among Campus-Corporate-Community" and also included Social Innovation Hubs, Tech-Transfer Academia, Diversity & Inclusion Programs, Sustainable practices, Zero Hunger initiatives, Sanitation & Smart Cities, Inclusive Environmental Growth, Continued Commitment and Responsibility as sub-themes. Dr. S.J. Kala, and Dr. P. Shyamala, Deans of Research organized the programme.

The competition consisted of three rounds where the first round was submission of abstract and the second round was video presentation and the third one was powerpoint presentation on 22-02-2024. Minimum 2-3 participants are allowed in a team. Overall, 39 teams from Fatima College and 13 teams from other Colleges participated in round one. The abstracts were evaluated by Dr. S.J. Kala, Dean of Research (Shift-I) and Dr, P. Shyamala, Dean of Research (Shift - II) for the innovative and social relevance. Out of them, 15 teams from Fatima College and 10 teams from other colleges were selected for the second round.

The second round was conducted on 19-02-2024 at 10 am for evaluating the video presentations of the students. Dr. T. Jeyanthi Vijayarani, Associate Professor & Head, Research Centre of Commerce, Dr. Fernando Delishia, Associate Professor & Head, Research Centre of English, Dr. S.L.Kumari, Associate Professor, Department of BBA, Dr. M.V. Leena Chandra, Assistant Professor, Research Centre of Physics, Dr. N. Malathi, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology and Dr. B. Vinosha, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry were the Jury members. All the video presentations were screened and the presentations were evaluated for their innovative ideas. Five teams from Fatima College and Five teams from Other Colleges were selected for final presentation.

The final round was conducted on 22-02-2024 at 9.00 am. The programme was started with the Prayer. Students' council President, shift I, S.K. Jaya Harini welcomed the gathering. In the Inaugural address, Rev.Dr.Sr.G.CelineSahaya Mary, The Principal, emphasized that the
