Through Rally students spoke about the importance of Farmers and Farming. After that students were divided into two groups to distribute the Vermicomposting fertilizer made by our college to the village people who are having lands. Distributed the 4kgs of Vermicomposting to the 11 families in the village, where they planned to use it for their crops or for their saplings.

Students were asked to collect the details of the families who are having own lands. From these, 24 families was having own land and they are mostly yielding Paddy, Sugarcane and Coconut plantain trees in their fields.

Students were asked to collect the feedback about the farms and lands and about the farmers. Most of the village people responded that their farming has been decreased and agriculture is been drastically destroyed due to many unexpected natural calamities and they don't receive any schemes from the government. Only they received the subsidy for fertilizers from the government. Finally after completing the process we departed from there and returned back to our college.



National Farmer's Day or Kisan Diwas 2023 is celebrated annually on 23 December to mark the birth anniversary of former Prime Minister Chaudhary Charan Singh.On 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023, 41 students of 3rd **B.Sc. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY** of **FATIMA COLLEGE**visited the village THIRUMALNATHAM, which is nearly about 18kms away from our college and celebrated Farmers day. The students of IT were formed as 4 groups and met the villagers.

**Team 1:** Our visit aimed to understand the challenges, successes, and the overall narrative surrounding farmers and farming practices in Thiruvedagam. During our visit, we engaged in conversations with both men and women from the community. They shared their valuable experiences, shedding light on various aspects of farming. Many farmers expressed concerns about unpredictable weather patterns affecting crop yields. Additionally, they highlighted the financial strain due to rising input costs and fluctuating market prices. Despite the challenges, several farmers shared innovative techniques they have adopted. These include water conservation methods, organic farming practices, and the integration of technology for crop monitoring.

**Team 2:** We celebrated the farmers day by collecting information from the farmers when they doing their favourite thing. They told many experiences about their plants, land, garden and everything. We learned from the farmers there which trees take how long to grow. For example he said banana trees take 12 to 14 months and palm trees take three to four years. We asked them that are there any alternate national pesticides that are environmentally friendly practices to replace chemical pesticides, they had said that they would use Grounded mint, garlic paste with some chilli powder and dissolve it in the water and spray it as a natural pesticides.
