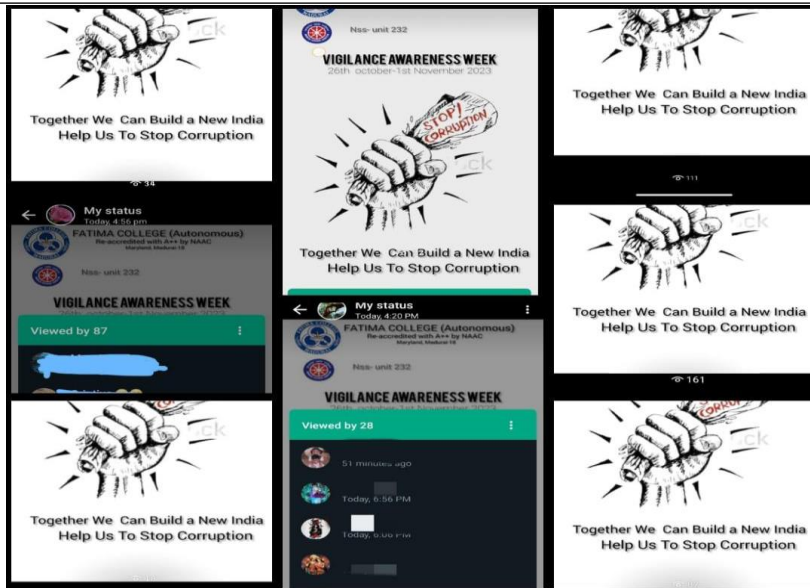

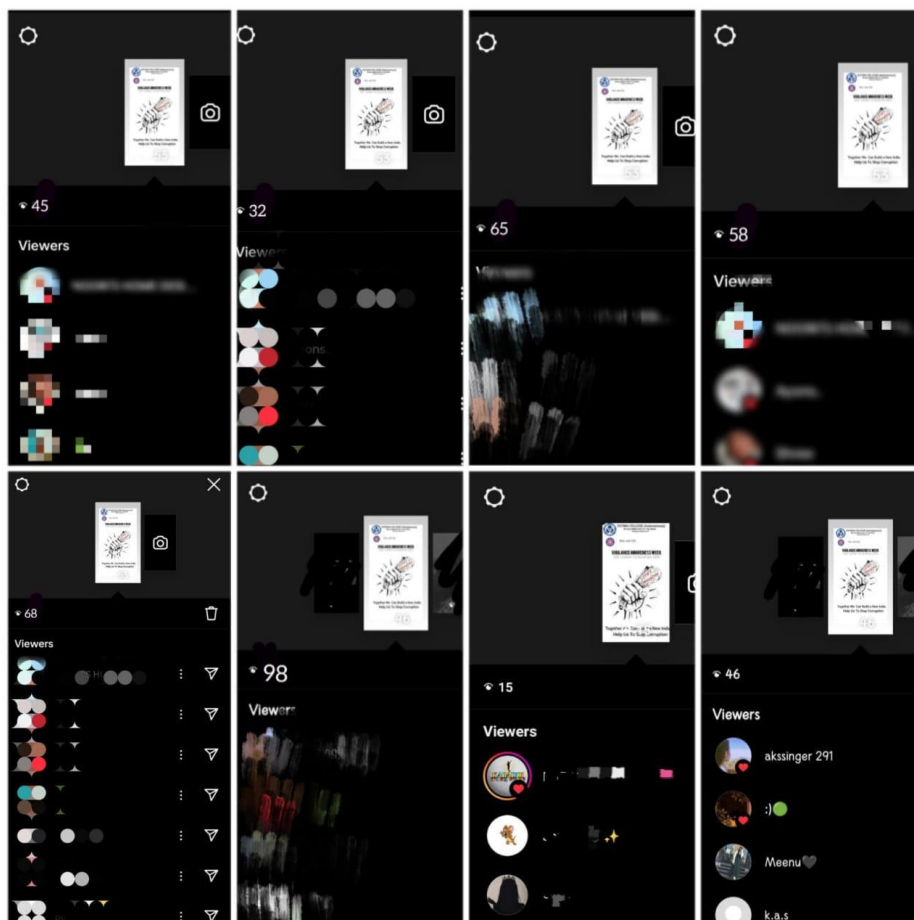

WhatsApp status of Awareness on Corruption posted by the Student Volunteers



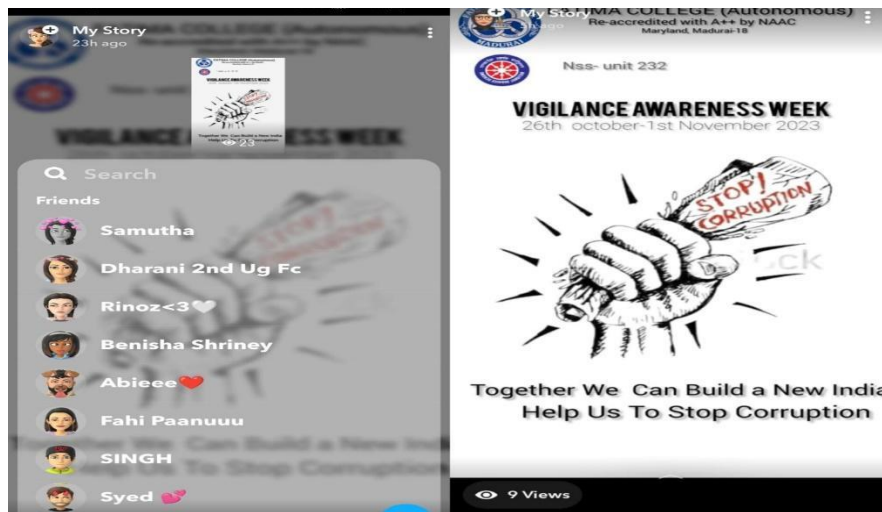
Instagram status of Awareness on Vigilance posted by the students

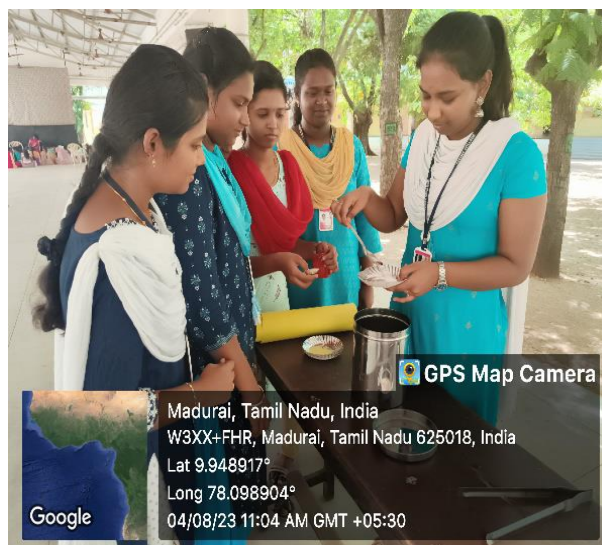
