

Reach Out to Society through Action (ROSA)

ROSA is the flagship for Extension activities of Fatima College. Initiated in 2006-2007 ROSA aims at providing opportunities for experiential education for the students, enabling them to apply the knowledge they acquire in classrooms for the benefit of the neighbourhood community. It is in line with the College Vision: "...to empower women by developing human capabilities through quality education ...making them responsible citizens who can work for the advancement of the society..."

Extension activity is designed as an **off-campus program with 3 credits** for the Final year students. It has a general objective of the upliftment of the underprivileged, reaching out to the unreachable, caring for the education and health of rural children, revitalizing the self-confidence of young women and making them financially independent by providing them entrepreneurship skills.

The activities are streamlined and focused on women, children and youth, covering health, literacy, women empowerment, environmental awareness and other concerns of our times. Fatima College is working for the development of **16 villages** in Vadipatti Taluk.



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Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is a flagship programme of the Ministry of Human Resource Development with the intention to enrich Rural India. Fatima College is one of the **Participating Institutions** selected in a challenge mode based on our contribution to societal development.

As per requirement, our institution has identified five villages, namely ThirumalNatham, Nedungulam, Vadugapatti, Ambalathadi, and Kondayampatti, in consultation with the District Collector, and has built a good rapport with the people. So far, the college has conducted Participatory Rural Appraisals and formed a Stakeholders committee in each village.

The students carry out various activities in the villages. They create awareness of current trends, technology, the spread of diseases and other social issues. They take special classes for the students in the villages.

The faculty and students participate in the Gram Sabha meeting on August 15 and January 26 in all the UBA villages and represent the key problems of the adopted villages.

The faculty and Student Community of Fatima College is committed to carving out a generation that would take an active role in social activities. The Extension Committee is reaching out to the underprivileged and thereby works towards nation building.





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

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




