TETE –A-TETE SERIES WITH AUTHORS- 2020

In the lockdown due to Covid 19 pandemic, when the whole world is unable to meet their loved and dear ones, the Research Centre of English, Fatima College, organised a virtual meet with eminent literary writers under the title **Tete-a-Tete Series with Authors- 2020**. Under this lecture series, two lectures were organised by Dr. S. J. Kala, Associate Professor and Dean of Academic Affairs and Ms. A. J. Bernita, Assistant Professor along with Dr. S. J. Kala's research scholars.

The first lecture of the series titled “**Tete-a-Tete with Poet Laureate Stephen Gill**” was conducted on 25 July, 2020. Stephen Gill is an acclaimed Indo- Canadian writer whose writings largely deal with the diasporic experiences, love and peace. The first intimation and the invitation were posted on social media and 68 participants from various parts of India registered for the meet. The staff members of the Research Centre of English and department of English (SF) also participated in the meet. The event was conducted through Google meet. The meet began with a prayer song, followed by welcome address given by Dr. Fernando Delishia, Associate Professor English. Dr. S. Kala introduced the author and highlighted the special features of writings of Stephen Gill.

After the introduction, Stephen Gill spoke about his writings, his personal life and his inspirations. Then Ms. E. Pratheebaa, research scholar under the guidance of Dr.Kala, who does her research on the writings of Stephen Gill interviewed the writer. She posed various questions pertaining to his life and his works and Gill answered all her questions very patiently. Next, the participants asked certain questions to Stephen Gill and received their answers from him. The even came to an end with a vote of thanks by Ms. A. J. Bernita.

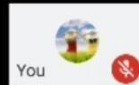

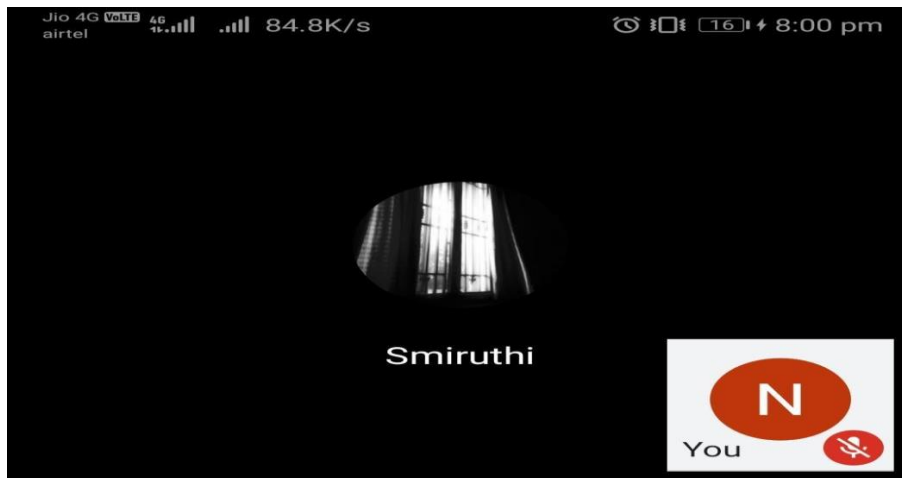
