“Read! Read! Read and that’s the basic thing for a budding journalist to equip themselves”, said Mr Vinodh Arulappan, chief bureau of The New Indian Express (south-Tamil Nadu) in an online session on ‘Career Opportunities for Students of Journalism’, organised by the department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Fatima College on 09.07.2020 exclusively for the students of the department . Google Meet platform was used for the session.

Sushmita Balakrishnan of III JMC gave the welcome address and introduced the Resource Person. The resource person gave a glimpse about the current scenario of the Print Media field which is affected by pandemic, Covid-19. Final year student, Shalini Valavanthan conducted the question answer session. She raised a several on the topic ‘career opportunities for students of Journalism’ on behalf of the participants. The Resource person responded to all the questions from his personal experience in the journalism field.

He advised the students to follow virtually all the Editors of news agencies to get current updates. He also pointed out that being active in social media like Twitter and Facebook would help to be recruited as the recruiters might view the applicant’s social media handle to have an idea about the candidate. The candidates should have some special talent which is relevant to the media field other than their academic syllabus”, he added.

While asking about freelance journalism, he advised the students to do this even while doing UG or PG as it has more scope now and English online news portals have more opportunity for freelance journalism than Tamil online portals.

He also added that patience and empathy are the most needed essences for a good Journalist to survive in this field”.

He concluded this session by advising the students to do internships seriously and not for the sake of certificate as it holds a major place for getting practical exposure in this field.

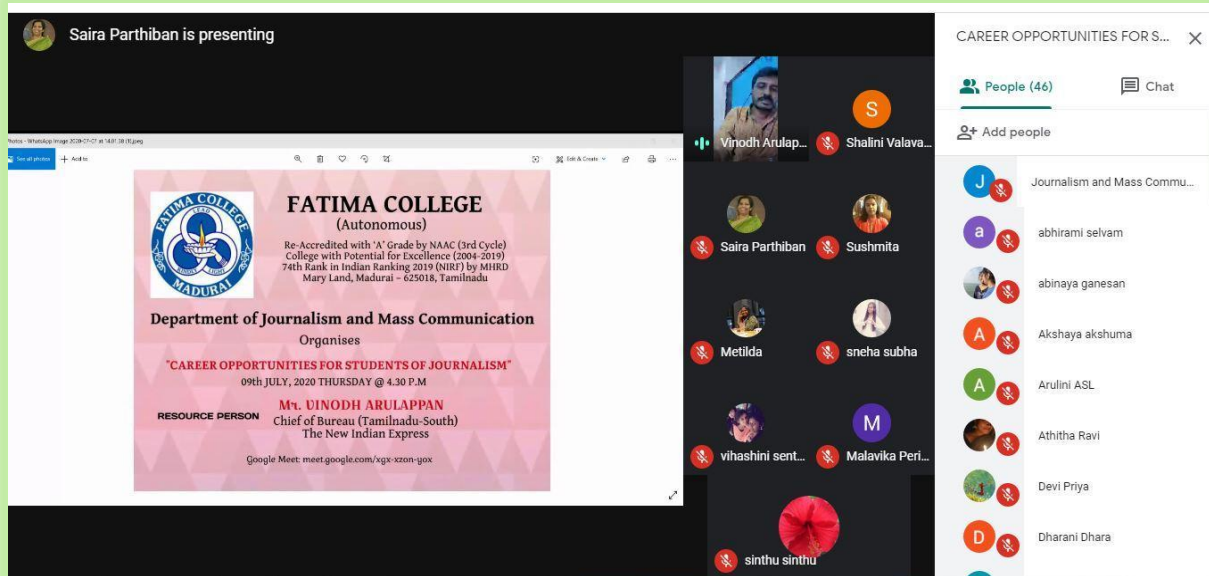
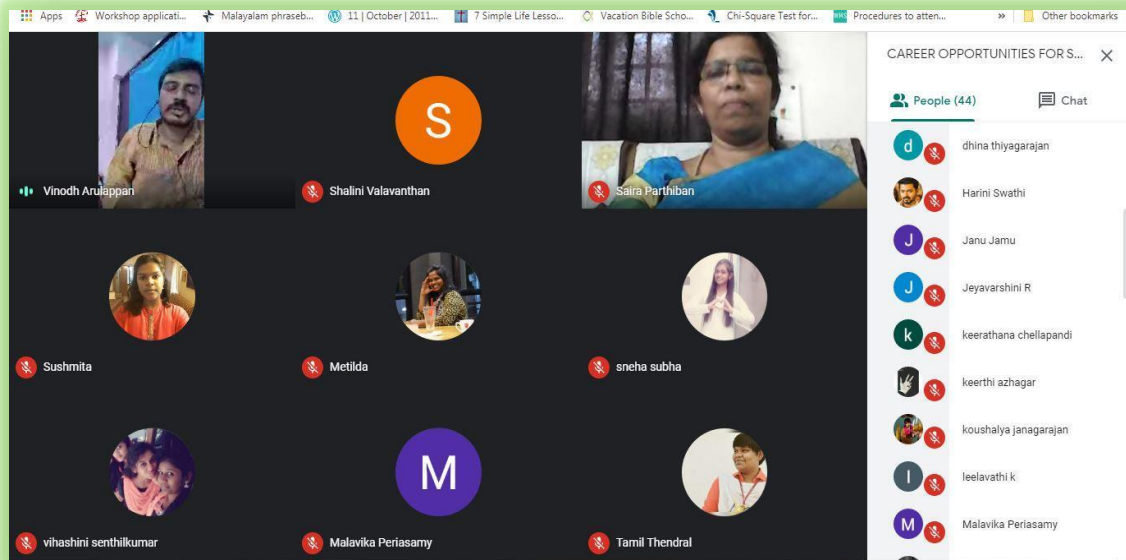

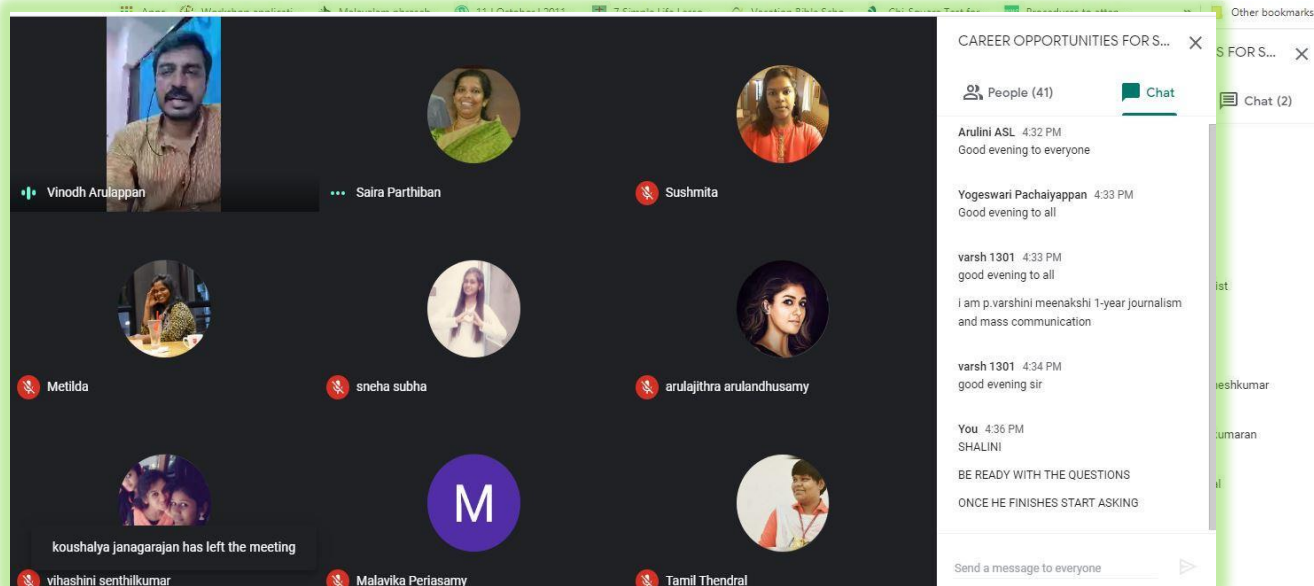
