Octavio Paz, a prolific writer of Mexican nationality, owes to his credit innumerable works on literary and art criticism, poetics, Mexican politics, history and culture along with his astounding contribution to poetry and essay. His poem "Between Going and Staying" depicts the indecisiveness of human stance at any part/point of life. Octavio Paz, with the mechanism of spiral movement, touches upon the subtle through the concrete; intangible through tangible. The poem is artistically designed in a way to experience the truth through exploration that provides a panoramic view of microcosm. The poem is schematically structured in tune with the thematic movement. The intentional placing of paradoxical elements proximately is yet another methodology of the poet to demolish qualitative supremacy/prejudice. His pluralistic view is evident through such examples that underscore the concept of holistic perception/evaluation.
