

India is the world's 7th largest country by area and the 2ndmost populous country with more than 1.3 billion half is the world's 7th largest country by area and the 2ndmost populous country with more than 1.3 billion scients. India is located in south Asia, bordered by the Bay of Bengal, the Arabian Sea, the Indian ocean, so is also bordered by the countries of Pakistan, Bhutan, China, Nepal, Myanmar, Srilanka and Bangladesh.

As of today's data, the world's population is estimated by the United States census bureau to be 1714 billion. India's 2019 population is estimated at 1.37 billion based on the most recent UN data.1 of every specifie on the planet live in India and between the 2001 and 2011 censuses, the country grew by 17.7% axing 181.5 million people. The country has doubled in size in just 40 years and is expected to unseat china as the world's most populated country in the next couple decades. India's current yearly growth rate is 1.08%.

The country as a whole has a population density of 416 people per square kilometre mile which ranks 31st in the world. In Mumbai, the population density is 21,000 people per square kilometre (54,000 / square mile). 36% of the population is urban (460249853 people in 2019). The median age in India is 27.0 yrs. Net horease of 1 person every 2 seconds.

While India's population growth has slowed remarkable over the last few years, it's still growing faster than think is expected to surpass china in population by 2028, when both will have about 1.55 billion people.
