In order to encourage more young voters to take part in the political process, the Government of India has decided to celebrate January 25 every year as National Voters Day. The day is also utilized to spread awareness among voters regarding effective participation in the electoral process. With an aim to promote democratic value **The National Voter's Day** was celebrated on 25.01.2016 in the College premises. Students took oaths and that was on the reaffirmation of our faith in us, our country and democracy. Followed by that there was an interaction session of the student volunteers with the booth officers with regard to inclusive and qualitative electoral participation.

Further on the National Voters Day, an awareness programme was arranged for all the NSS volunteers of Fatima College to sensitize them to participate in the election. Dr. Pappa, Assistant Professor, Tamil Department enlightened the students about the process of election, reasons to vote, and emphasized the basic right of every citizen to vote. She also briefed about the History of Indian Election Commission, various aspects of voting, right age to vote and details about voter identification cards.

Karthiga of II B.Sc. Physics delivered a speech on responsibility of students and essentiality of the voters to be aware of the political parties, background of the candidates and several other information to help them cast an effective vote.
