**Number of Beneficiaries** : Villagers of the three villages

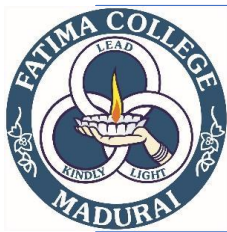
**Number of Students involved** : 70
