NSS Wing of Fatima College organized the massive blood donation camp on 22.09.16 in collaboration with the Govt. Rajaji Hospital Madurai for students and staff members. Secretary, Rev. Sr. Dr. Francisca Flora presided over the programme and explained the significance of blood donation to all the students. She shared her experiences of blood donation during her college days. Dr. Mercy Joyston, Govt. Medical officer, Govt. Rajaji Hospital, gave a brief lecture on the importance of blood donation, at what intervals women can donate and the duration for successive donation and how it helps both donor and the patient. The camp was held in the presence of Dr. Mercy Joyston and her team members. More than 130 students enthusiastically volunteered for blood donation. These students were initially screened for HB count, adequate BMI tests and out of them 91 students were qualified for blood donation. The donors were given certificates and refreshments.

OUTCOME: Students learned the importance of blood donation and actively took part in it by donating their blood.






OUTCOME:


