As a part of NSS activity, a program on “**Awareness on demonitization**” was held on 02.02.2017. The resource person of the program was Dr. S. Dhinakaran, Associate Professor, Department of Zoology, Madura College, Madurai. Currently, he holds the position of District Coordinator, Tamilnadu Science Forum. He gave an awareness speech about Demonetization in India and discussed the pros and cons of the act made by the Central government. He said it has advantages like decline in black money, end to fake currency, Obstacle for terrorism, Reduction corruption and at the fair end, even the politicians will have to face fair Election. The disadvantages were like inconvenience to common people and the burden in exchanging old notes. He concluded that the victory of this act will depend upon the implementation and it appeals everyone to contribute for the cause.
