Disaster is a sudden, calamitous event that seriously disrupts the functioning of a community or society and causes human, material, and economic or environmental losses that exceed the community's or society's ability to cope using its own resources. International Day for Disaster Reduction, held every 13 October, noting how people and communities around the world are alert to reduce disasters and to raise awareness to cope with risks of disasters that they face. The basic aim of the commemoration was to sensitize the community to learn from disasters and play its role as socially responsible citizens.

As per the communication received from the District Collector, Madurai, (L.R.No. 43940, dated 07.10.16) NSS wing of Fatima College commemorated International Day of Disaster Management on 13.10.2016. Various competitions namely, English & Tamil Elocution, English & Tamil Essay writing and Painting competition were held to encourage students to take part in the thought provoking process of disaster management and mitigation. Interested students from all disciplines were allowed to participate.

As part of the disaster reduction day commemoration, a mini model display was also held where the students shared their ideas on awareness on disaster reduction, preparedness and management at various levels of natural and manmade disasters. Though often caused by nature, disasters can have human origins. Students outpoured their ideas of reducing the involvement of the human component in the origin of disasters. They exhibited their models on disaster preparedness under versatile adverse situations namely Crowd management in Madurai during festivals, Hygiene and sanitation during monsoon, Mosquito and Dengue prevention, Fire safety measures at shopping mall, Earthquake preparedness-structural aspects of buildings, Global warming – CO₂ Management, Man- made disasters-removal of oil spills in water and Rain water Harvesting.

OUTCOME:

Educated the students on the concerns of reducing risks and losses of lives and properties caused by natural and other disasters.

Students were made aware of the importance of managing risks especially to people's health and well-being at time of disaster. Showcasing students talents and skills.

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
