As per the communication received from District Collector, the 8 units of National Service Scheme (NSS), Fatima College participated in road safety program from 04.02.2019 to 12.02.2019 to invoke importance of road safety among the students and to the public. First year NSS volunteers were entrusted in implementing this awareness program.

Road Safety awareness activities were planned and executed various events in the college and in public places. **NSS volunteers were involved in public awareness about traffic rules to reduce casualties due to road accidents. Awareness campaigns on ‘Road Safety-Life Safety’, nukkad natak, folk song and dances were also performed to impart the role of road safety. Rally was organized by repeating slogans regarding road safety. Also, painting and posters were displayed to create awareness among the public.** Detailed reports for the performed activities are as follows.

- A session on ‘Road Safety’ was arranged for volunteers to create awareness on road signs, awareness on control and safety devices and to outline good Samaritan guideline awareness insisting on the rights of good Samaritan and duties of police and hospitals and procedure to be followed during an emergency. Thiru. Manoharan, Inspector of Traffic and Thiru. Ramesh, Sub-Inspector of Traffic, Madurai delivered an awareness talk to the NSS volunteers highlighting the role of college students in road safety.
- Millions lose their life and millions get injured in road accidents globally; mainly, due to lack of awareness about traffic rules. Hence, Do’s and Don’ts – Mandatory signs were described by the police personnel to students.
