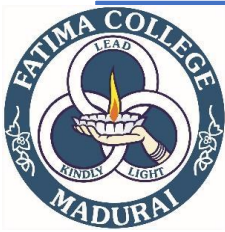
#### Participation of Children for Rally on Literacy Day in Thirumalnatham Village

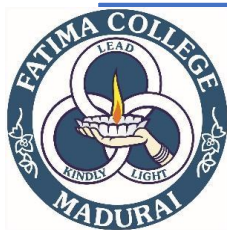

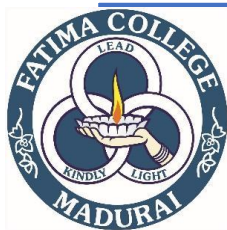

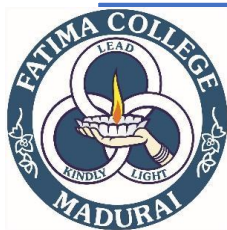
