SWACHH BHARAT SUMMER INTERNSHIP – 2018

Swachh Bharat Summer Internship (SBSI) is to engage youth across the country and develop their skill and orientation for sanitation related work and village level development. The program aims to bring youth across the country an opportunity to make a significant contribution to the Swachhata revolution. Duration of this program is 100 hours. Candidates may participate individually or in teams. Candidates are eligible to choose between the State of Residence and State of Parent Institution as the location of internship (village/district).

In Fatima College, 50 students registered for this program in teams of 10 students each. They are working in Kondayampatti village, Alanganallur block, Madurai for 100 hours in 15 days from 28th May to 13th Jun, 2018. They actively participated in Swachh Bharat work in themes like, solid waste management, composting pit, sanitation, open defecation free environment.

SBSI was inaugurated by the Principal, Dr.Sr.G.CelineSahaya Mary, Fatima College, Madurai. She emphasized the importance of Cleanliness and personal hygiene and encouraged the students to bring out transformation in the village and also to help the underprivileged in terms of sharing the facts and create awareness on hazards of using plastics and open defecation. Sister also appreciated the students for spending their holidays for the good cause. The students were working on the projects like organic waste composting project, awareness project on personal health, women & adolescence, creating awareness on better sanitation practices, collection and segregation of solid waste into biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste and creating awareness on cleanliness through Wall painting in Kondayampatti village. They created awareness on sanitation and open defecation through street plays, door to door meetings, wall painting, and cleaning activities.

Valedictory function was conducted on 13th June, 2018, 3.00 pm at Kondaymapatti village in the presence of the Principal, Dr.Sr. G. Celine Sahaya Mary.
