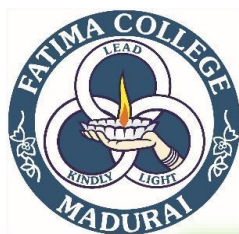
The staff and students of the Research Centre of Tamil participated in the Stakeholders meeting held on 04th of August 2018. Almost 15 people participated in this meeting.

Kondayampatti, a village selected under UBA, a flagship programme of the MHRD, is an adopted village for Fatima College. A team of five members, including the staff in-charge of the Extension Programme visited and attended the Stakeholder meeting of Kondayampatti village. The team observed the village and made friendly interactions with the villagers, in order to ascertain the issues to be addressed. The team explained about the purpose of their visit to the village and about having conducted tuition, medical camp, spreading awareness about Dengue & Malaria in the last 4 years and about the need for the creation of the Stakeholders Group.

Later it was decided to conduct the meeting once in a month to take tuition for the students of the village and to conduct workshops for the village women on small jobs that can be done at their houses. Further, the following problems faced by the village people were discussed.

- Toilet facility is not available to both male & female villagers. Available toilets are not maintained.
- No water facility available
- No Bus facility
- No compound wall in the school

The villagers were convinced of the need to move towards a clean India, and their co-operation in making Kondayampatti clean was elicited.

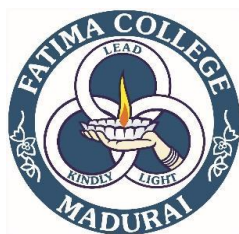
