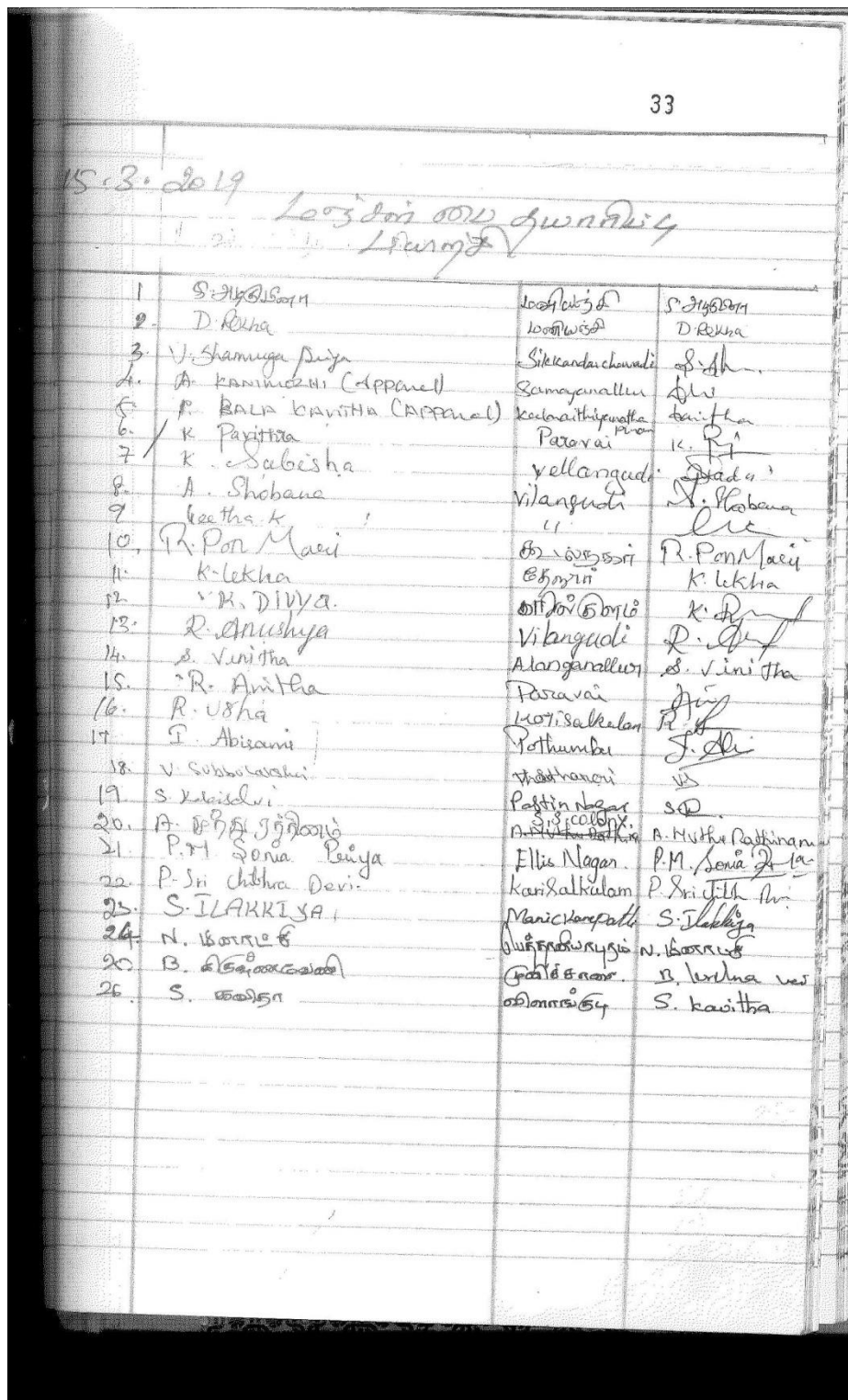
ROSA- Reach Out to Society through Action Skill Training Programmes

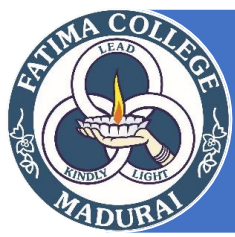
Name of the Department	: Three representative from various Department
