In the process of enlightening the young minds, the NSS unit of Fatima College invited **Ms.Barathi Kannama**, a transgender lawyer, to educate the students about the struggles transgenders encounter in their day to day life and how they are also getting empowered with the recent awareness about their status in society . She shared her personal story, about how though her parents were supportive not all were with the same mentality. She was stereotyped and had to constantly fight through prejudiced notions about the transgender community. She particularly spoke about an incident that happened while she was travelling in a train. The fellow passenger assumed that she was there to beg and threw a disgusted look at her. Later she had to clarify that she too was a passenger. She proudly spoke about the instance when she met Mr. Bill Gates. She educated the students on how a transgender feels and how they expect to be treated in the society. In the discussion session, many students registered that the session was very useful and that the prejudices they had were shattered. Students clarified their doubts and shared their experiences with her. The program ended with a vote of thanks and national anthem.

OUTCOME: The students learnt about the problems transgenders face and the need for accepting them into the mainstream and facilitating their empowerment. They also had many of their doubts cleared.
