On 4.8.19 at 2.00 P.M., extension students of the Department of Chemsitry visited Aachampatti Village (along with staff in charge Dr. B.Suganthana and Dr. R. Sarika) and conducted an awareness programme on Road safety among villagers.

Objectives of visit

- To organize awareness programme on road safety for the people of Attachampatti.
- To teach the village people to follow the fundamental traffic rules and road traffic legislations.

Observation

It was observed that there are many accidents occurring on roads. So our chemistry department students took an initiative to organize an Awareness programme on Road safety among villagers of Attachampatti.

Analysis

Continuous efforts by the State Government through Transport, Police , Health, Highways and Education departments resulted in the reduction in the number of accidents. It was reduced by 24 percent. Number of accidental deaths during 2018 was 12,216. This was 24 percent less when compared to the statistics of the previous year 2017, which was 16,157. During January 2019, 5173 road accidents have been reported in the State. Accidents were reduced through creating more awareness on road safety among public continuously by educational institutions.

Activities Carried out in Attachampatti Village

1. Distribution of pamphlets on road safety by students to village people and they were taught about

- Various Traffic Signals
- Fundamental Traffic Rules
- Road Traffic Legislations
- Motor Vehicles Act 1988
- Offences and penalties
- Using Helmets while driving two wheelers
- Fuel consumption etc.
