Our ROSA Extension of Fatima College conducted the webinar 'National Education Policy' on 22.09.2020 at 1.00 pm. Final Year UG students from Fatima College and people from our ROSA adopted villages, to tally 340 members took part in this webinar session.

The session started up with welcome address by **Dr.SusaiJecinta Mary** of Fatima College

who warm up this session with her beautiful speech and stood as a host throughout this webinar

Sr.M.ArulVinnarasi, Coordinator, ROSA, Fatima College highlighted the NEP and its difficulties. She also pointed out that this policy will bring back ancient skills and thus students can develop their skills with innovative ideas and the new syllabus help to crack competitive exams such as NEET and hence it will be easier for all standard of pupils. Also, she listed out the difficulties on this new policy scheme such as rural pupil may get affected by the insufficient guidance and it may spoil the impact on adult Education.



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In the first session **Dr.Ragam**,NSS Coordinator of Fatima College, highlighted the following points on NEP

- Schooling starts at 3 years of a Child. The new system will have 12 years of schooling with three years of pre schooling and emphasize 5+3+3+4 structure for 3-8, 8-11, 11-14 and 14-18 years
- NPE focus on students' Mother tongue as medium of instruction in both private and public schools till grade 8.
- Vocational Education will start in schools from 6th grade including internships
- Public and private higher institution will be governed by same set of norms for regulation.
- Multiple entry and exist options in degree courses. Undergraduate degree will be of either 3 or 4 years duration with multiple exit options. Colleges will be mandated to give certificate after completing 1 year.
- The NEP offered targets of research. Higher education syllabus is light but tight. Small number of schools join together and become large school.

In the second session **Dr.Poongodi**, Assistant Coordinator of ROSA Extension, shift II, of Fatima College give a short note on the benefits of NEP through her inspiring speech. She pointed the pillars of NEP access, equity, quality, affordability, accountability transforms India into Vibrant knowledge hub.

- It focuses on skill development of students
- It Reshape the corporate world through digitalization.
- It provides good education for the next 25 years.

In Queries and Discussion Session many students and the people from rural areas arise their queries and doubts to the resource persons about NEP. The Coordinator gave detailed explanation and thus she clarified their doubts.

Then Dr.Jecinta delivered her vote of thanks to all the Resource persons and the participants of the webinar. Thus, the webinar ended successfully.
