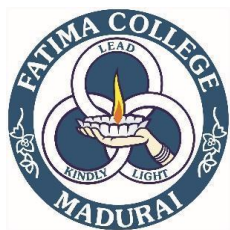

Ms. Annie Epsiba, the project coordinator, Mr. Radhakrishnan, instructor and Ms. Teresa, interpreter from CCM Deaf Connect Team were the guest speakers. The program was organized by NSS in the premises of Fatima College. Ms. Annie Epsiba started the session defining what sign language actually is. She spoke about the personality of the hearing impaired people and how they cope with the world. She then went ahead to explain the intricacies and the limitations of sign language. She explained the goals of CCM and urged the students to be a part of this beautiful effort to make the world a better place for the hearing impaired people. She then briefed about the importance of communication and where it starts. She ended her interactive session with the overview of the disability. Mr. Radhakrishnan, who is a hearing impaired person, taught the students alphabets and basic words in sign language with the help of her interpreter Ms. Teresa. The students actively participated in the program and learnt the basic signs happily. At the end of the session many expressed their willingness to learn more sign language by joining hands with CCM. The program ended with the national anthem.

**OUTCOME:** The students learnt the psyche of hearing impaired individuals and the sign language.

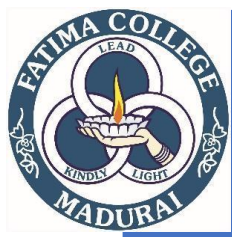

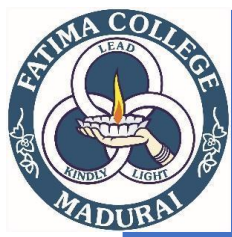
