He discussed on the diagnosis of cancer using nanotechnology which has brought revolution in cancer detection and treatment. He also discussed about how specific cross linkers such as antibiotics are used against cancer cells location. He shared his views on how

certain nanomaterials can also deliver cancer drugs at the site. So the drug toxicity can be reduced.

The afternoon session was revised by Dr.T.Stalin, the guest of honour on “Interaction of host-guest complexes with light and its applications”. He discussed host-guest relationship and how it encompasses the idea of molecular recognition and interaction through non-covalent bonding. He explained how dendrimers along with host-guest complex are used in medicine, to improve the drug delivery by increasing the solubility and bio-availability.

The valedictory address was given by Rev.Dr.Sr. Francisca Flora, Secretary, Fatima college. She shared her experiences and work related to the nanotechnology.

The programme ended up with vote of thanks given by Dr.B.Medona, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry, Fatima college.
