As a part of NSS activity, program on "Cancer Awareness" was held on 17.12.2015 in the premises of Fatima College. Theresource personnel of the program were Dr. Alagu Ganesan, surgical Oncologist and Mrs.Reavathy, Executive, from Vadamalayan Hospitals, Madurai.Dr. Alagu Ganesan, gave an awareness speech about Breast and Cervical cancer through videos and power point presentations. He emphasized the increase in the risk for breast cancer with increase in the age. A brief awareness about symptoms were given and he explained about the nature of the cancer cyst and the students were taught to identify it. He advised them to carry self examination which should be carried out few days after their menstrual cycle. He also said that the average life time risk for breast cancer is 1 in 8, most being diagnosed at the age of 50. Further he also briefed about cervical cancer, its causative virus called Human papilloma virus which can be detected by Popsmear test and Colposcopy test. He also gave interesting information about the vaccines that prevent cancer which would be available soon in India. "This session about self examination and cancer prevention made us overcome the inhibition to self examine ourselves appear for cancer tests." This was their feedback statement by the students. Pamphlets about Cancer awareness and discount cards for the students were given. This session would have entirely benefited the students and inturn they would have spread the awareness to their family and friends.



An awareness program on tuberculosis was organized on 11.02.2016 for NSS volunteers in the premises of Fatima College. Mr. Lingusamy, Advocate, Partnership for TB care and control, and Mr. Saravanan, District Coordinator, National Tuberculosis control Programme were the guests of honour.

Mr. Lingaswamy addressed the students regarding the disease tuberculosis and its causes, symptoms and treatment. He said Tuberculosis or TB is an infectious disease caused by *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, which most commonly affects the lungs. It is transmitted from person to person from the throat and lungs of people which is the active respiratory disease. He also emphasized that usually this disease develops in persos with poor immune system. He said it is often misunderstood as a genetic disorder which is not true and occurs in three stages. According to the stages diagnosed, the treatment also differs. The symptoms of acute tuberculosis ranges from coughing sometimes with sputum or blood, chest pain, weakness, weight loss, fever and night sweats.

Students were keen to know about the disease control methods and prevention, methods to build our immune system, ways to diagnose at early stages and the possibility of reoccurrence etc. The guest speaker also gave the students enormous information on their doubts. The program ended with student volunteers and programme officers taking oath on spreading awareness in the prevention and control of tuberculosis.

Report of Release of Documentary Film "RIVER ONCE"

The students of the 2014-2016 batch of MA English of the Research centre of English produced a documentary film titled "River Once" in collaboration with DHAN foundation Madurai . 44 students under the guidance of Dr.P.V.Christi Shanthi and Dr.Mary Magdalene Abraham, Associate Professors of the Department and Mr.Krishnamoorthy of DHAN made an extensive study of the ancient and holy river Kiruthumal .

The aim of this documentary was to bring awareness to the people of Madurai on the need to restore the Kiruthumal. The river is now a sewer and most parts of it have disappeared under encroachments.

The team took two full days to film the origin of the river at Pulloothu tracing it through the heart of the city. Many residents, Panchayat leaders, historians, and elders were interviewed. The film was given extensive coverage by the media (attached) and the corporation officials were impressed with its outcome.

G. Periasamy, Deputy Hy-



Rev. Sr. K. Fatima Mary, Principal, said that the documentary should prick the conscience of people.
