④ Freshers shall be instructed to promptly report any attempts of ragging Committee.



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⑤. A Student seeking admission in hostel shall submit an additional affidavit countersigned by her parents that, she will not indulge in ragging.

PUNISHMENT:

Depending on the nature of the offence as established by anti-ragging Committee the following punishments shall be given for those found guilty.

- Cancellation of admission
- Suspension from attending classes
- With holding (or) withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing for test (or) examination.
- Suspension (or) expulsion from hostel.
- Imposing fine
