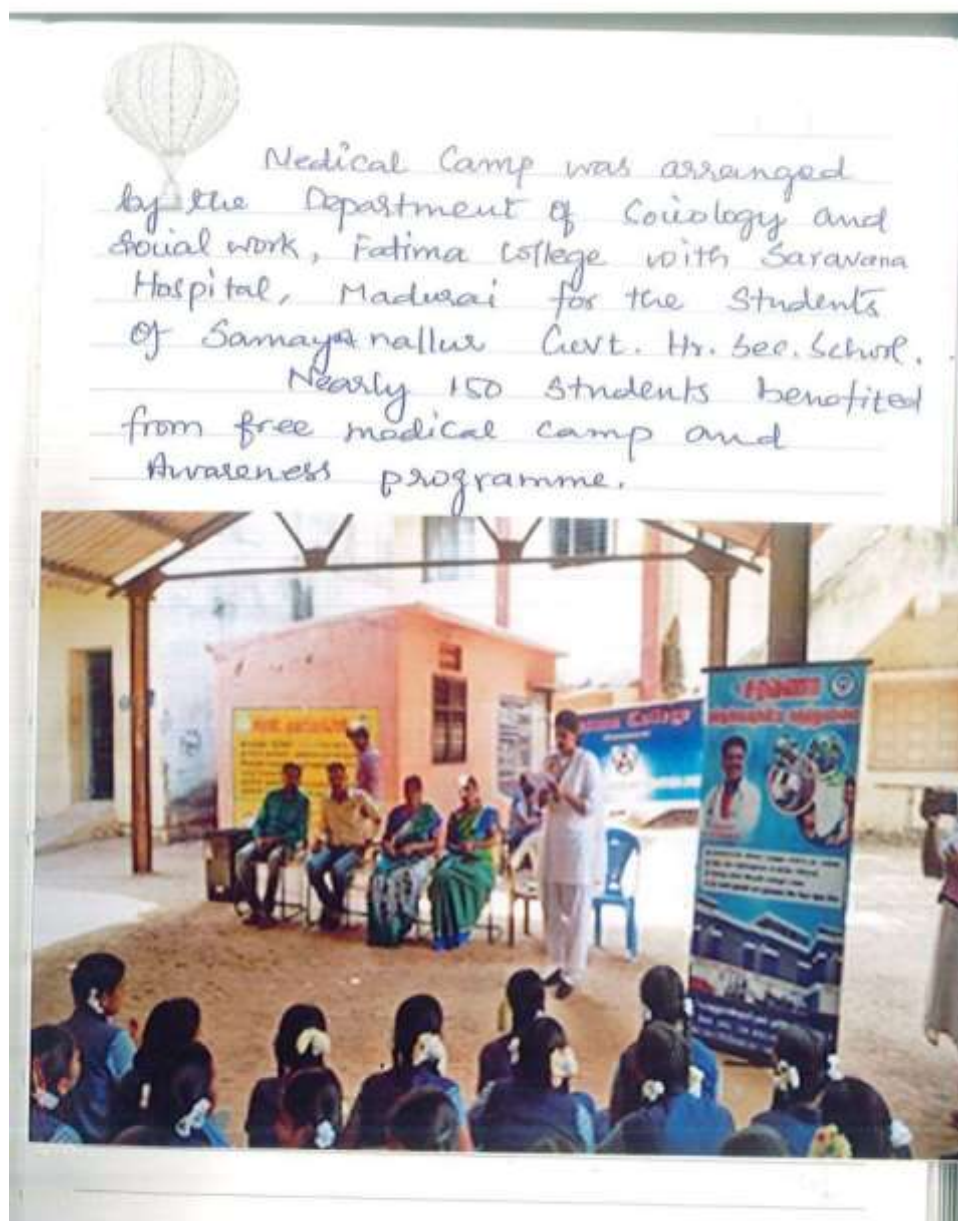
The programme chief guest, Mr. Manikandan M.E., Director, Grow Yourself Organization, Madurai. Also, he insisted on giving importance to value of time and life.
