## **THEME: “VIVACIOUS YOUTH: VIBRANT INDIA”**

### **1) NAVARASA NATEYAA!!:**

Number of participants : 2

Time limit : 5 minutes

Criteria : Expression, Costume, Co-ordination.

### **RULES:**

- ❖ Songs can be of the participant's choice.
- ❖ Only classical dance like Bharathanatyam, MohiniAttam, Manipuri, Odissi, Kathak, etc. are allowed.
- ❖ Audio CD should be brought.

### **2) SYNCRO DANCE (LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION):**

Number of participants : 6 to 8

Time limit : 5 minutes

Criteria : Quality of presentation, imitation, co-ordination.

### **RULES:**

- ❖ Song should be a fusion of folk and western.
- ❖ Costume should be suitable to both forms of dance.
- ❖ On the spot adaptation of costume is allowed i.e. (Removal or addition of certain accessories).
- ❖ Participants are requested to imitate film songs only. (no private albums are allowed.)
- ❖ Video CD of the fused song imitated should be brought by the participants.

❖ Dressing must be modest.

Number of participants : 2

Time limit : 45 minutes

## **9) ORU VARTHAI ORU YUGHAM:**

Number of participants : 2

Time limit : 5 minutes

Criteria : To find 10 words, for each word, 3 clues are allowed.
