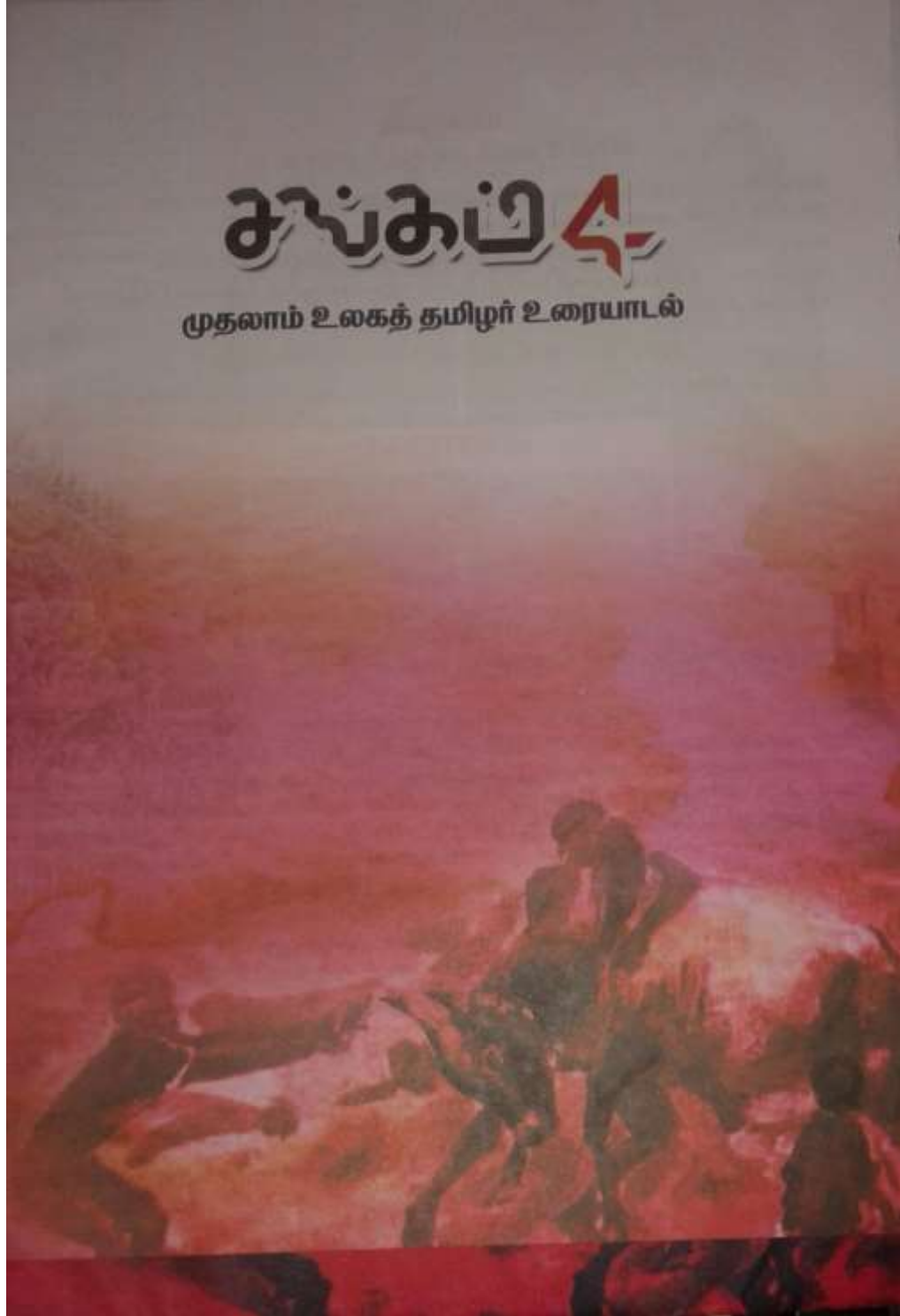

REPORT

Madurai Sangam 4 celebrations were organized on Fatima College Campus on 16.08.2016. The campus was vibrant with many parallel sessions taking place at different

venues throughout the day. The events were inauguration of Rural Olympics, Rural Olympics Meet, “Thani Tamil Iyakkam 100,” Interschool & Intercollegiate Cultural Meet and Photo Exhibition.

The Inaugural of Rural Olympics took place at 9 a.m in Sports Ground. The Guests of Honour were Mr. Murugesan, Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, Madurai and Mr. Solai M Raja, President of Tamil Nadu State Amateur Kabaddi Association. Rev. Dr. Francisca Flora, Secretary of Fatima College and Rev. Dr. Fatima Mary, Principal of Fatima College honoured the Guests of Honour. After flag hoisting and lighting the Olympic Torch, the students of “Madurai Silambam Association” performed Silambam feats. Then the students of Fatima College staged a colourful Fan Dance known for its uniformity and artistic beauty; following it the sports students of Fatima College presented gymnastics in which their mind and body danced in unison. Mr. Murugesan, in his felicitation address, was in all praise for the sports students as they have the tendency to treat triumph and defeat the same. Then he declared open the Rural Olympics Meet. Following it, indoor and outdoor Rural Olympic Games were held at different venues.

The “Thani Tamil Iyakkam 100” Conference was organized at SJ5 at 10 a.m. The conference hall throbbed with the intellectual deliberations of great speakers like Professor Srinivasan, Mr. S.P.S. Ganesh, Mr. Gnanaguhan, Mr. Venugopal, and Mr. Balaguru. The highlight of the conference is prioritizing natal tongue. The representative voices were from different languages like Urdu, Gujarathi, Telugu, Malayalam, Hindi, Sourashtra, Kannada and Bengali underlining the peculiar features of their first language. Though they had come to Tamil Nadu centuries ago, they still cherish how Tamils embraced them as brothers in spite of cultural and linguistic differences. They took pride in calling Tamil their Father Tongue. Professor Srinivasan, after tracing the origin of Tamil and Tamil culture, underscored the current scenario of Tamil in Tamil Nadu. But for its pride as the official language of Tamil Nadu, Tamil had lost its ancient glory, he said. He stressed the importance of preserving one’s Mother Tongue.

The Interschool and Intercollegiate Cultural Meet took place in Jubilee Hall from 10.30 a.m to 3.30 p.m. Drawing and dance competitions were held. 16 schools and 12 colleges actively participated in the competitions. The dances echoed the salient features of Tamil folk specifying the importance of Madurai. Drawings reflected the theme “Restoring Vaigai” with special reference to past, present and focusing onto future.

A photo exhibition was arranged at the back end of the Jubilee Hall. "Osai: Voice from Nature" Trust exhibited rare photos pertaining to Tamil Culture. Photographs of the birds and animals of Tamil Nadu that had become extinct and that were towards extinction were displayed. Also the snaps of natural landscapes that had once been green and fresh were exhibited.

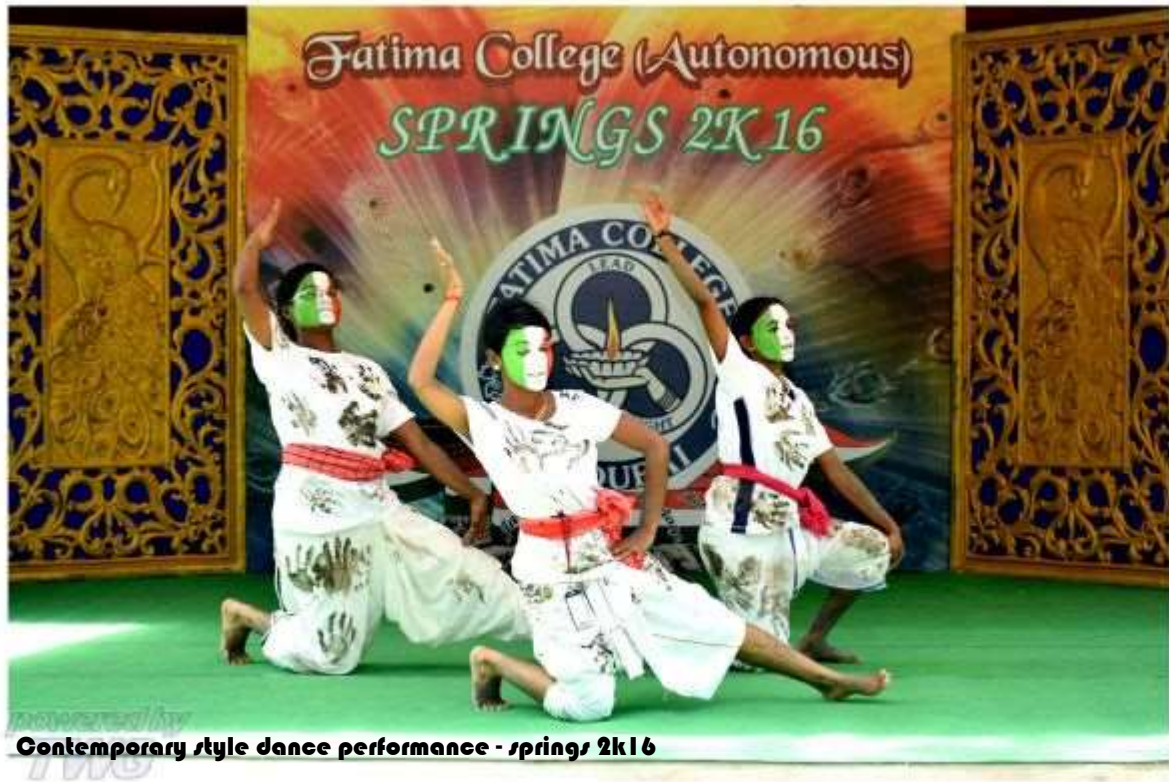
