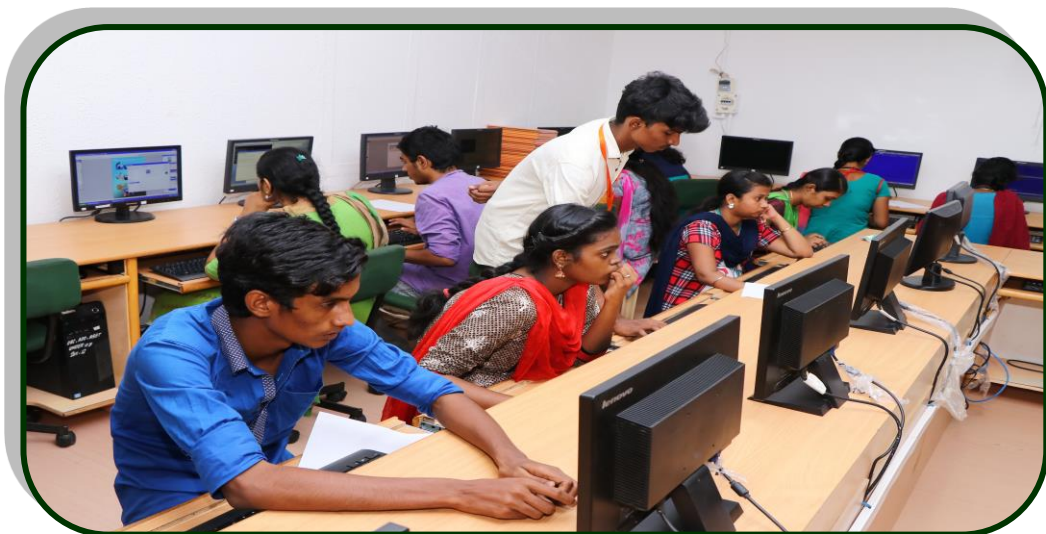

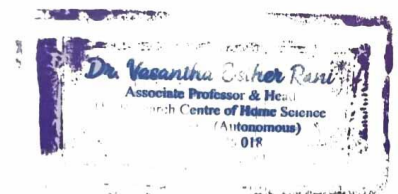
## NUTRIFEST 2019

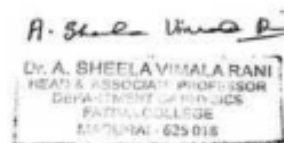

Judges were invited from various departments within the college. The participants were rated on a rating scale of marks and based on the average score of the judges the first three winners were finalized.



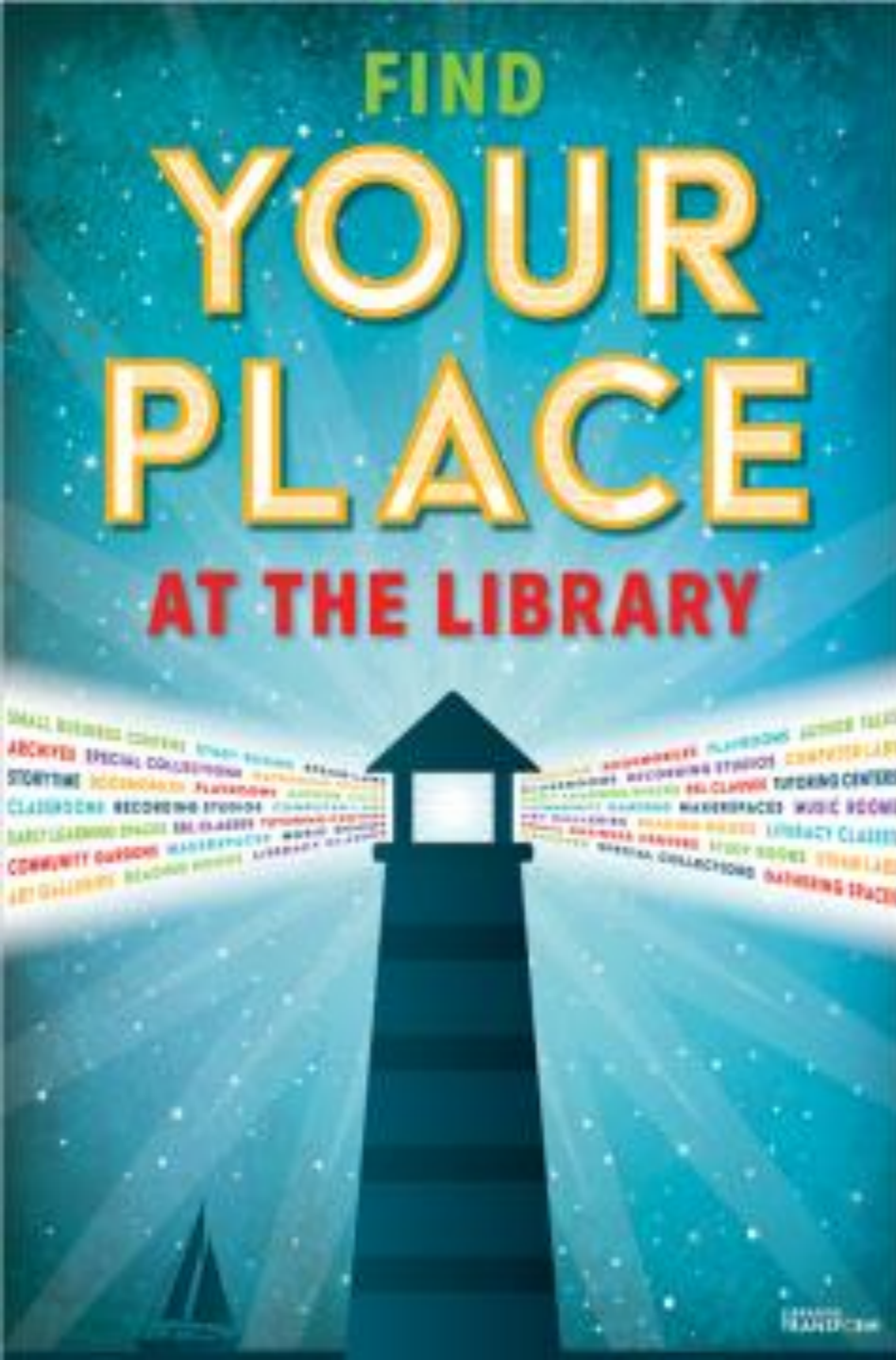

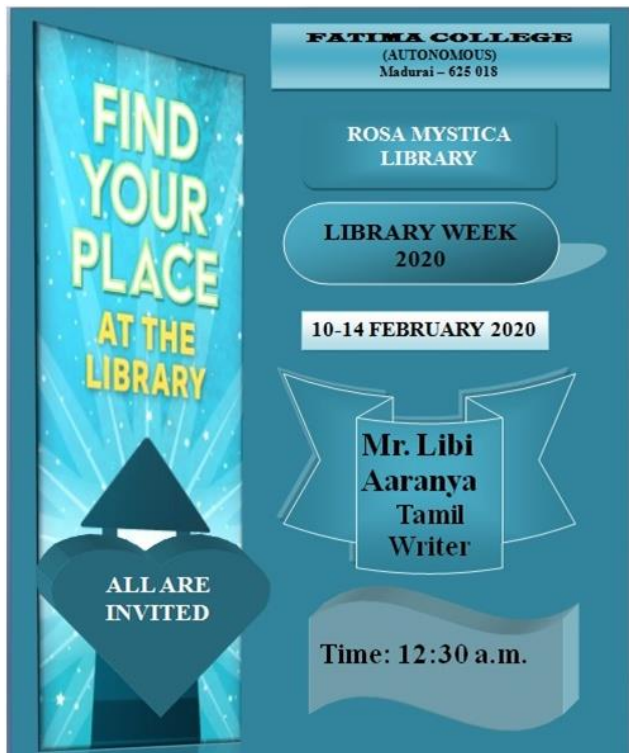


## LIBRARY WEEK 10 – 14 February 2020 Report

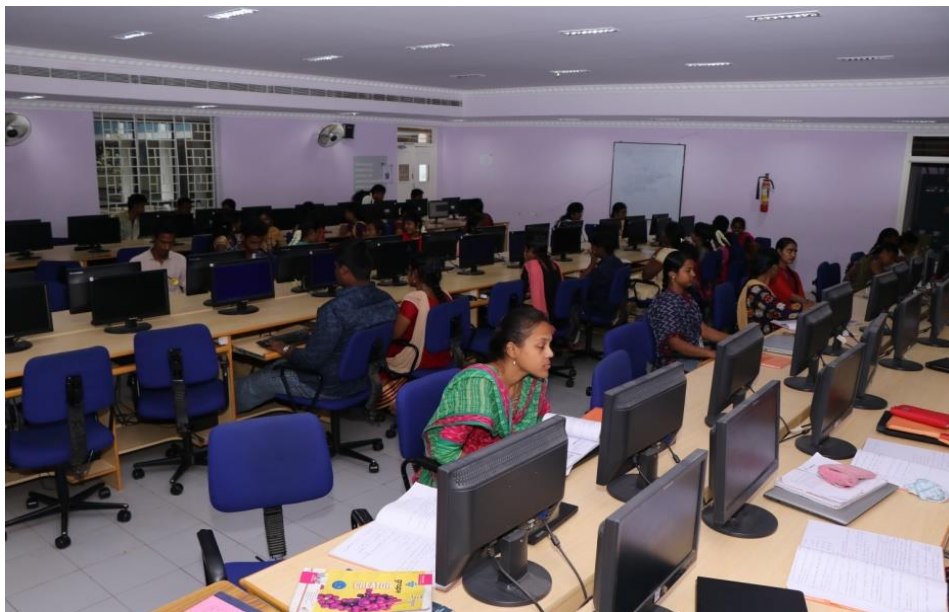

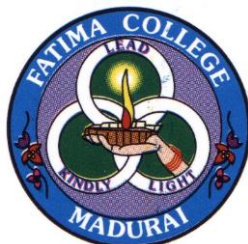
