**REPORT**

The Faculty Training Programme for the newly recruited faculty was organized by the IQAC of Fatima College from 15/06/2017 – 22/06/2017. The main aim of the programme was to initiate the faculty into the culture of their new workplace, to introduce them to their new roles and responsibilities and to prepare them to face the awaiting challenges with the right attitude and utmost dedication to work.

The **seven-day programme** started prayerfully, with a song by Dr. Sarah Evangelin, and prayer by Dr. Sr. Biji. The **Coordinator of IQAC, Dr. Auxilia Felicitas welcomed the gathering**. She introduced the Secretary and the Principal, the two important pillars of the College, to the participants. Then she briefly stated the purpose of the Training Programme.

**The Principal Dr. Sr. Celine Sahaya Mary** expressed her happiness in meeting the new faculty, who, she hoped, would work with a sense of commitment and responsibility and rise up to the high standards set for them as bench mark. She congratulated them for having chosen this noble profession through which they can impact many students, and thereby the society in general. She emphasized on the fact that each one has to make one's unique contribution to the development of the college and its students.

The induction started with the session by **our Secretary Dr. Sr. Francisca Flora** on the topic **“St. Joseph's Culture and Legacy”**. She gave a special explanation to the sublimity and greatness of the creation of God and highlighted how man is just a microcosm of the Macrocosm of the Universe, its Galaxies. She spoke about the presence of God in our hearts, which will give us strength and maturity to face challenges of life. She explained how between every stimulus and response there is a gap. In that space created by the gap we choose to act positively or negatively. How we respond depends on God's grace.

She then discussed the concept of 'Dynamism', which meant being fully alive. But there are dragons within us which hinder our dynamism, like horror, ego, mistrust, fear, attitudes and prejudice. God's Grace will help us to chase these dragons out of our system.



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Sr. Flora then gave a detailed account of the legacy of St. Joseph. It started with six women. It functioned with charism, a special gift of God. She enlisted the Principles of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyon:

- Trusting in the providence of God.
- Living with the will of God
- Moving towards excellence.
- Possessing the pioneering spirit of taking a leap in the dark while facing opposition
- Having faith, genuine love, friendliness, being united.
- Fulfilling the needs of the marginalized people.

On 16/06/2017 Dr. Sr. Francisca Flora gave the participants an insightful glimpse of the culture of Fatima College. It is founded on unifying love. The inspirational leadership is behind the progress of this college has been working with a sacrificial service attitude. To work in accordance with Fatima culture would mean prioritizing work, focusing on priorities, building our own brand, commitment to excellence, courage to take risks, reinforcing the core values and earning the trust of the stake holders. The sessions were well presented with significant points interspersed with supportive videos.

**Dr. Alexander Pravin, Department of Commerce, Dean of the School of Management Studies, St. Joseph's College, Trichy, and external expert of our IQAC,** was the resource person for the session on 17/06/2017. He shared his thoughts on the topic **“Role of Teachers in Higher Education.”** He briefly traced the evolution of higher education and put forth the idea that there is a widening of the knowledge gap, the gap between the knowledge we possess and the knowledge the students require. He highlighted the following points:

- Student engagement is very challenging for the teacher
- An in-depth reading of the subject is needed
- Mastering the technology is also very important for the teacher
- A good teacher must perform the role of a facilitator
- Voice modulation is essential to keep the class alive
- Students should be encouraged to ask questions

Finally he discussed the role of institution. The institution has to create an environment for the employees to be empowered. Students expect the “Return on investments” (ROI) from the institution. The teachers and the institution must be ready to provide it. Both the institution and the staff members have to be sensitive to the happenings of the society.





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“Teacher’s Decorum” was the topic for the session presented by **Mrs. Fernando Delishia, Associate Professor, the Research Centre of English**, on 19/06/2017. She discussed the 5 Ps of teacher’s decorum:

- Perseverance
- Preparation
- Pupil centredness
- Punctuality
- Peace

After elaborating on these points she moved on to the quality of “Integrity”.

Qualities associated with integrity are:

- The staff are expected to be faithful to the institution and to the senior staff
- They should be impartial
- They should be punctual

Her next focus was on ‘leadership qualities’. Under this topic she laid emphasis on the need for teachers to possess qualities like willingness to shoulder responsibilities, problem solving capacity, ability to face criticism, and being decisive and bold. She also gave tips for anger management, an essential soft skill for teachers.

**Dr. Latha, Associate Professor, Department of Home science with FBT** shared her knowledge on “Professional Ethics” on 20/06/2017. She stated that a Professor is expected to

- Strive for Excellence
- Be trustworthy
- Be courteous, respectful
- Be honest, open and transparent
- Be competent and learn continually

She listed out some of the qualities of a teacher. Appropriate dress code, communication skills and courteous manners play a vital role in the physical and emotional grooming of a professional teacher. She also gave suggestions as to how a teacher can move on from being a good teacher to a great teacher. She introduced the five ‘C’s approach to teaching: Collaboration, Communication, Critical thinking, Creativity and Caring.

The sixth day’s session was presented by **Dr. Shyamala, Head of the PG Department of Information and Technology**, on 21/06/2017. The topic of the day was “Group Dynamics and Team Building”.



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She focused on four points:

- 1) Why we need teamwork?
- 2) Qualities of teamwork
- 3) How to build a team work?
- 4) Stages in team building.

The session was very interactive with lot of fun-filled tasks. The key points presented were: believe in the team, be honest to the team, be an inspiration to the team by being what you are, focus on the task, be soft on people but hard on problem, deal with conflicts constructively.

The four paradigms of human interaction are lose/win, win/win, lose/lose, win/lose. A good team work should aim at the win/win situation. The resource person also showed videos of inspirational teamwork of ants, penguins and crabs. She concluded by saying that if 'I' is replaced by 'we' even illness would become wellness.

The last session of the Programme was conducted on 22/06/2017. **Dr. Saira Banu, Associate Professor, the Research Centre of English** presented a summary of the ideas shared by **Dr. Bernard D'Sami, Director, Loyola Institute of Social Science Training and Research (LISSTAR) Loyola College, Chennai**, at the Orientation Programme for the other faculty of the college on the topic "**Vision and Mission of Higher Education in the present scenario**". She also supplemented the presentation with her own views on the topic.

Dr. Sami had enlisted three important roles of higher education:

1. Expansion
2. Inclusion and
3. Excellence

- **Expansion:** Networking with other national and international institutions create opportunities for exchange programmes. Clusters of colleges can be created to share infrastructure and resources. Bringing world class resource persons to our college is also important. Expanding our knowledge towards ICT enabled teaching and effective use of e-content material is inevitable nowadays.

- **Inclusion:** Our teaching methods should include all categories of the students. The teacher should give equal importance to students who belong to different economic, cultural, social and religious categories.

- **Excellence:** The teachers should set high standards for themselves. There are no universal parameters for excellence. Hence each individual and each college must develop her/its own unique standards of quality and excellence.



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The Alumnae of the college should be encouraged to contribute to the development of the college. No compromise should be made in the quality of syllabi or conduct of examinations for the sake of passing all the students. The members of the faculty must become experts on specialized areas and equip themselves to serve as resource persons sharing their knowledge with other institutions. The teachers should excel in research activities of their respective field. The science teachers may concentrate on getting patent rights for their research inventions.

Dr. Saira Banu explained the vision and mission of the college. There are teachers who are self-oriented, student-oriented and society-oriented. A good teacher needs to strike a perfect balance among these three. The teachers should work with a sense of ownership and strive hard to take the institution to great heights. Certain basic information regarding NAAC was also shared with the participants. The session was very interactive and interesting.

The Programme came to an end with the Valediction. The participants submitted a written feedback and shared a few responses orally. They were highly appreciative of the usefulness of the thoughts shared and knowledge gained in the course of the seven days and felt inducted effectively. The certificates were distributed by the Principal Dr.Sr. Celine Sahaya Mary.

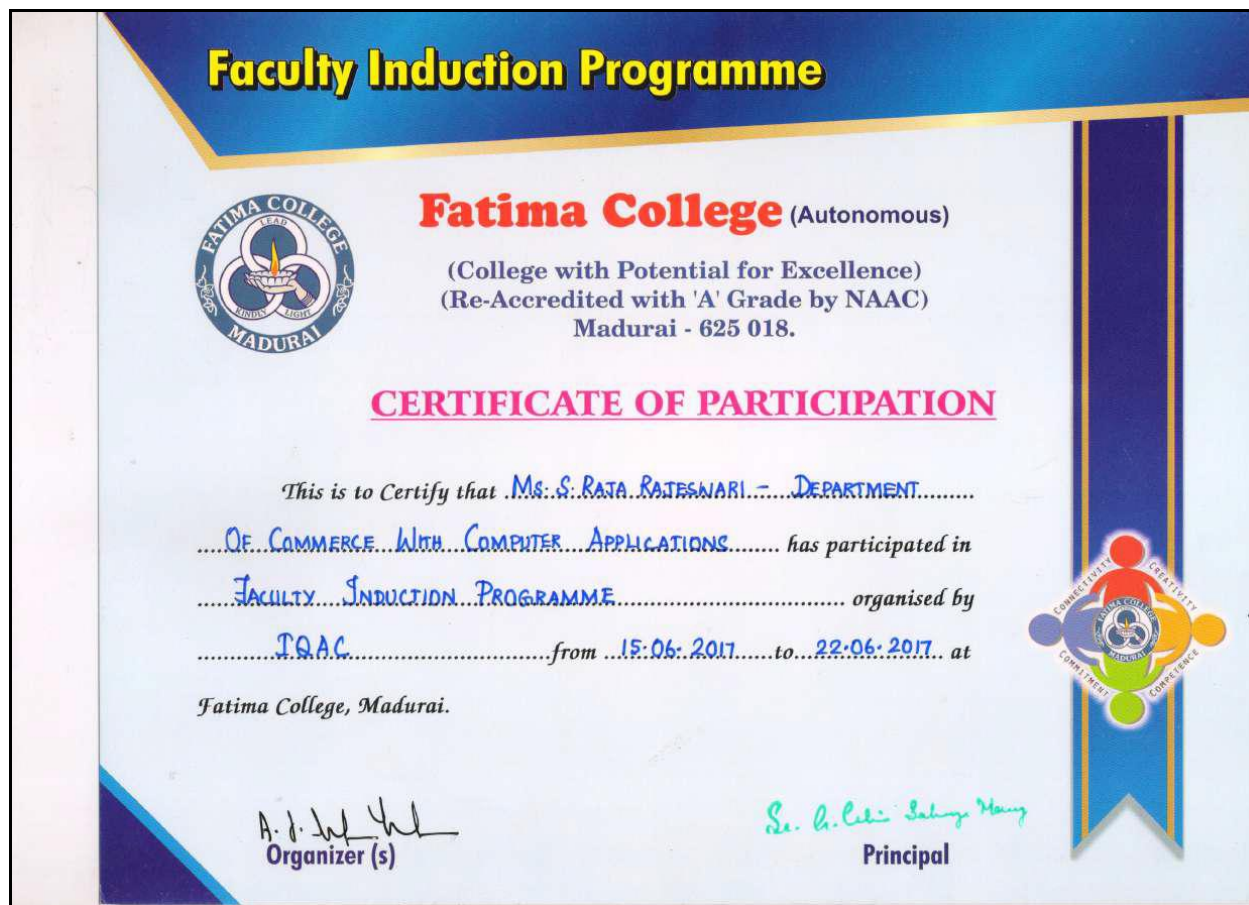

### REPORT

A one day Faculty Development Programme on “Alternative Teaching Methodologies” was organized by IQAC, Fatima College on 14 October, 2017 at the Jubilee Hall, Fatima College, Mary Land, Madurai.

The objective of the FDP was to provide opportunities for faculty members for the following;

- To enhance innovative teaching skills by familiarizing faculty members with alternative teaching methodology
- To motivate faculty members to apply the innovations in teaching.

The FDP was attended by 210 faculty members of the college.



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The programme commenced with the prayer song. Dr. Celin Sahaya Mary, Principal, Fatima College, gave the inaugural address. She appreciated the IQAC team for arranging the program. The Principal also motivated the faculty members to make the best use of the one day FDP. Dr. L. Meena, Assistant Professor, Department of MBA introduced the high-profile resource person, Dr. K. Samuel Johnson, Consultant-Trainer, Higher Education, VIT, Andhra Pradesh.

Dr. K. Samuel Johnson started his talk by appreciating the vision statement of the college and applauded the wonderful pioneering work of the founders of the college.

Taking the cue from the vision statement of the college,

***“Empower women by developing human capabilities through quality education based on Christian values, making them responsible citizens who can the advancement of the society and promote communal harmony in the multi-religious and multi-cultural reality of India.”,***

Dr. Samuel Johnson highlighted the noble objective of the college through the key words of the Vision statement like - Empower women, quality education, responsible citizens, advancement of society, and communal harmony.

Dr. Samuel Johnson was sure that **“The way you walked in will not be the same way you walk out of this FEP”**

Dr. Samuel Johnson elaborated on the importance of **family happiness** and added that it will lead to happiness in the college. Family happiness will

- **enhance better teaching environment in the class**
- **provide an opportunity to better understand the stakeholder namely, students and**
- **parents from their perspective**
- **convert classrooms into life changing centers**

Dr. Samuel Johnson started the post lunch session by introducing the concept of four different **Personality traits of students namely: Drivers, Expressives, Analytics and Amiables.**

He emphasized that a proper understanding of the above mentioned traits would help teachers understand the students in the class and facilitate their learning by creating a student-centered classroom ambience.

The resource person emphasized **the 3 Ps**, they are

1. **Practice**
2. **Proof and**
3. **Preach**



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Emotions will never play in developing a healthy relationship only truth and honesty will always pave way for a healthy relationship between students and teachers. He also underscored the importance of good working relationship within and outside the department.

**ECG** of life is directly proportional to life's frustration. Therefore, to keep the ECG normal one has to develop the art of positive reception. He also knocked at teachers' conscience on the importance of health and fitness of the teaching fraternity and the same should be imparted to students through teaching.

"You should feel very proud to be Indian women because as per the statistics available Indian women are more empowered than the women of other nations." He recalled Indian women occupying key positions in like that of the PM, CMs, Speakers, Defense Minister, Governors, and Leaders of Educational Institutions. In this regard, India is unique compared to other countries. Even in developed countries like that of USA, women are not chosen or given such huge responsibilities.

The present student generation is called the Gen Z also called as Gen-Alpha. Gen-Z are techno-savvy, social media communicators, and of course multi-taskers. As teachers, we have the responsibility of shaping the students' lives as well. At the same time we should also bear in mind that social media and technology should always be used to serve the community rather than destroy. As teachers, we need to exploit technology for the greater common good and it must enable us to make students' living conditions better. As teachers, we should also inculcate in students that technology should be exploited judiciously; it should be used to eradicate several social evils like corruption, violence, inequality, poverty, and illiteracy.

Technology will never replace teachers. In this millennium, in order to serve the Z-Gen students, it has become mandatory for teachers to learn and become accustomed to use technology for empowering students who are techno-savvy. We, the **Digital Immigrants** should adapt new methods to encounter the student community that can be described as **Digital Natives**.

Dr. Samuel John demonstrated how to add voice recording in PowerPoint (PPT) presentations and audio cum video and text in PPT through Camtasia studio. As digital teaching is going to be mandatory for all college teachers in the near future, the resource person reiterated that material production in digital teaching should be learnt. Dr. Samuel Johnson also listed a number of websites where free software is available. They could be downloaded for teachers to enable their developing of digital teaching modules to cater to the Gen alpha students

He also emphasized that learning should pave way for earning through updating of the syllabi to suit the industrial needs and to enable students to be competent in the job market. The entire day's activities were very interactive and the participants were





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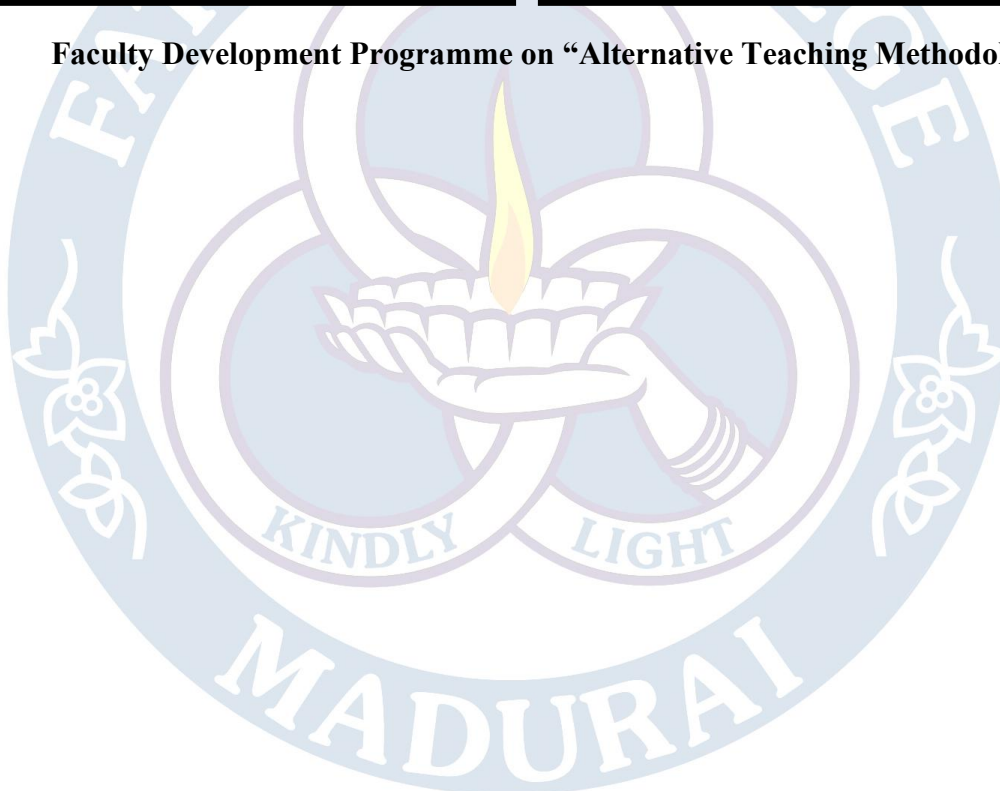

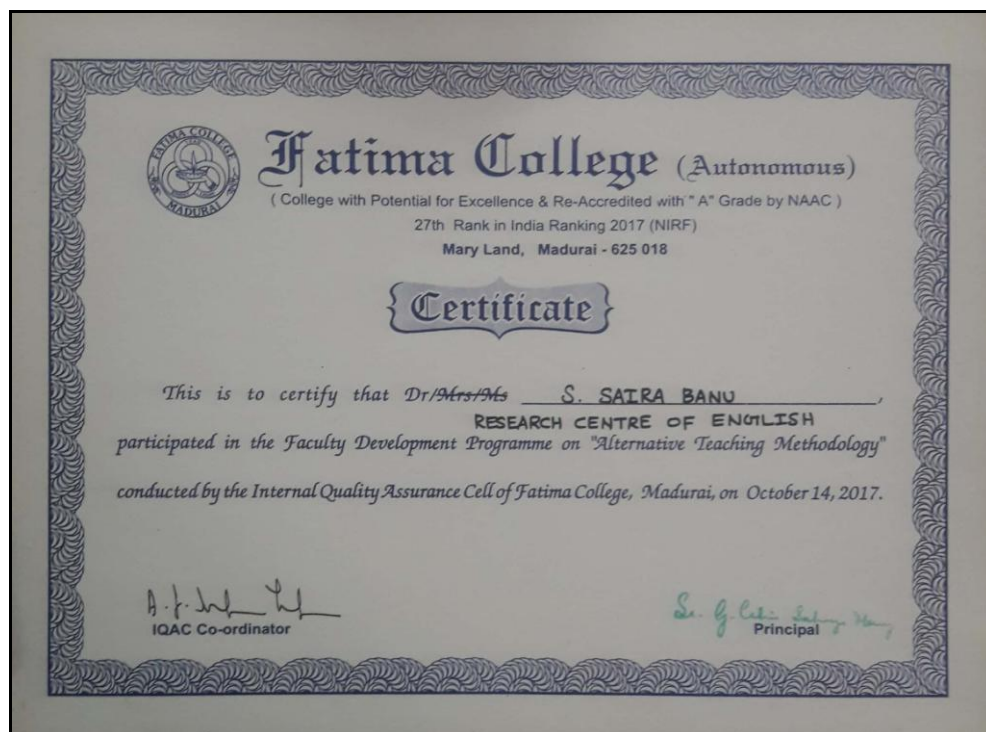

**REPORT**

A Faculty Development Programme on the topic 'Lead Kindly Mentors' was organized by IQAC on 11.1.2018 for the Teaching Faculty. Dr. S. Girija, Faculty Trainer and Management Consultant, was the resource person. Dr. Girija emphasized that technology can never replace teachers. She shared her views on the responsibilities of the staff in developing the students' personal and technical skills. Some of the highlights of her presentation were:

While dealing with students three 'C's should be avoided by staff – "Complaining, Comparing, Criticizing". She also recommended the 'N' strategy (the way 'N' is written '↑up – ↓down – ↑up') which means the students have to be treated in a positive way first, then the mistakes have to be pointed out in a way that could help the students to change for the better and finally their achievements have to be appreciated.

She shared her personal experience and motivated the audience to be active and energetic. A teacher should be physically and emotionally strong. Patience is an essential quality of the teacher.

The teachers should employ effective and updated teaching methodologies. It is the responsibility of the teachers to make a student develop reading habits. Appreciation makes a difference. Teachers have to generously appreciate their wards.

She advised that teachers should spend a minimum of 45 minutes every day for professional development and another 45 minutes for personal development. The teachers should be intellectually strong and morally upright. It is the duty of the teachers to inculcate good thoughts, acts, habits and characters in students and they should lead by their own example.

On the whole it was a revitalizing presentation, rekindling the teachers' passion for the noble profession. It was an interesting and informative session, delivered with lots of energy and enthusiasm and received with involvement and interest.

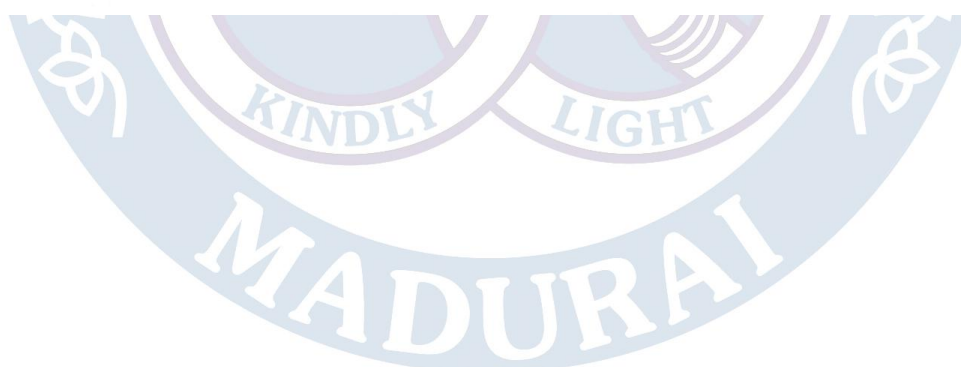

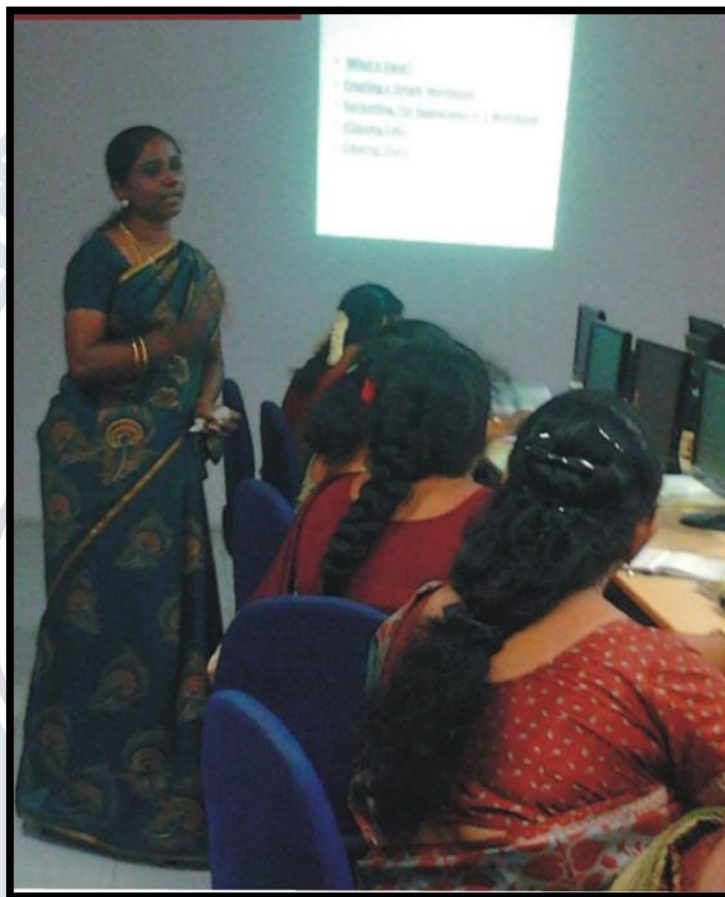
