The Orientation Program was held on Friday, 10th June and Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> June. Around 50 staff members(experience 5years and less) participated in the program. The program started at 9.30. Sr. Biji, Assistant Professor, Dept of Zoology welcomed and introduced the resource person, Rev.Fr.George, Salatian Priest. Rev.Fr.George started with a prayer.

#### **Ice-Breaking Session:**

Then the Ice- Breaking Session started with small games. The staff members felt relaxed and interacted with each other. They were asked to join in different pairs and share their feelings with each other. The sharing helped the teachers to recollect the things they love the most, the positive views they know about their pair and the reasons which made them to become a teacher, etc., Then few staff members talked about their experiences and shared their views.

### NAAC -4th CYCLE - Self Study Report (SSR)



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#### Session I: "Educators as Spiritual Agents"

The first session started with a documentary video of a Puppy Bear, Tiger and a Mother Bear. Then there was a discussion about that documentary. Fr. George discussed about how the obstacles can be changed to stepping stones. He also explained on how to feel the presence of God even when that presence is not felt and how teachers can become Spiritual Agents.

#### Session 2: "Refining and Redefining of the Modern Educators"

This session was on how to refine and redefine the educators. He quoted a saying "உன்னை அன்பு செய்பவர்களை நீ நேசி, உன்னை வெறுப்பவர்களை நீ அதிகமாய் நேசி". Then a video clipping of Mrs. Bharathi Baskar was played which focused on humanity. Reflections on the video continued with that. The key points focused were unwanted waste and unnecessary burdens (குப்பை) in our minds should be unloaded then and there. Unless they are cleared everyday, God's presence will not be felt. New ideas and changes should be accepted and all should be ready to learn new things. Father also shared about his own life experiences. Then he encouraged us to accept others as they are and not try to change them.

#### Session 3: "Educators as Value Promoters"

The Third Session started with an Action Song "Lalla Leru..." which made the staff members to sing and dance. It was followed by a group game "Blind" where three staff members tied their eyes and reached the destination by overcoming the obstacles with the help of other three communicators. It focused on Trust on others, Listening, Encouragement, Think Smart and Lateral Thinking, Kindness and Hospitality.

A video about duck and ducklings was played which taught about the smarter way to think. Then another video 'Naan Yaay' a Selvabharathi's film was shown. Character Formation is the best preferred way to Academic Excellence. Fr. George also shared many real life examples about why character formation is important. Another video of the speaker Barveen Sultana was shown which gave a different view of 'காக்கா வடை கட்ட கதை'. He highlighted that we have to create our own heaven here. Another video of 'Agada Vigadam' was played where a small boy of De Britto School gave new views on the topic 'Iyarkai'.



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#### Session 4: Ten Traits of the Highly Effective Educators

Fr. George highlighted the ten virtues of effective educators, like Communicator, Educator, Envisioner, Facilitator, Change Masters, Cultural Builders, and so on. He gave many real life examples on each trait.

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# Parent Teacher Meet for II UG 25.06.2016

Fatima College organized a Parent Teacher Meet on 25 June 2016 at Jubilee Hall. The program started by 10 a.m. with the dignitaries lighting the lamp. Ms. M. Priya Percy, Psychotherapist, Trainer, and Consultant, OASIS Institute for Personal and Professional Development, Madurai, was the chief-guest of the function. The objective of the meeting was to underscore the norms and protocols of the college and to create a rapport between the parents and the teachers for the holistic development of the students.

College choir invoked the Almighty through a prayer song. It was followed by reading from the Holy Scriptures: Dr. C. Sahayamary Sophia, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, from the Bible; Mrs. A. Gomathy, Assistant Professor, Department of History, from the Bhagavat Gita; and Mrs. A. Sarpia Rani, Assistant Professor, Department of French, from the Quran. Dr. S. Anburani, Assistant Professor, Research Centre of Tamil, delivered the Holy Message of the day. Mrs. A. Dev mala, Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil (SF), welcomed the gathering and introduced the chief-guest who was an alumna.

Dr. Sr. K. Fatima Mary, the Principal, elaborated on the objectives of the meeting. Emphasizing college as the moulding place for the students, she highlighted the etiquettes expected from the parents and the students to keep intact the established ambiance and integrity of the college. Narrating the various exposures given to the students by the college, such as add-on credit courses, diploma and certificate courses, consultancy service, campus interview, and awareness programs, the Principal emphasized the need for enhancing the communication skills of the students. Making a note on the regular attendance, focus on the positive aspects of the media, mandated catechism classes for the Christian students, college library and free web access, she briefed the code of conduct of the students, both day scholars and hostellers, underlining the prohibition of the usage of cell phone on campus at the UG level. She stressed the importance of completing their UG course before getting married and emphasized that the suitable age for marriage is twenty four.

The chief-guest Ms. M. Priya Percy, in the chief-guest address, defined Parent Teacher Meet as the bridge connecting the teachers and the students. This multi-faceted personality explained how she utilized every opportunity provided by the college, being an NCC cadet, athlete, dancer and sociology student. She spoke on the values of tolerance, forgiveness and understanding. She strongly recommended preventing the usage of abusive language at home as it would create a negative impact upon the students. Also, she appealed to the parents to be good friends of their children thus supporting them in their endeavours. Pointing at the lack of self-confidence and self-love, she stressed the importance of both in the current scenario. Ms. Priya cautioned the students against the ill-effects of media and asked them not to become slaves of it. She advised them to be focused on their goals to achieve success in life.

Then, the Principal honoured the chief-guest with a shawl. Following it, Dr. Sr. M. Francisca Flora, the Secretary, delivered the special address. The Secretary, by citing 'Thirukural', opined how children were the gifts of God for which the parents should be grateful and how the children should help their parents by coming to the forefront in life. She narrated an interesting anecdote thereby paralleling the parents with the vulture to emphasize how responsibility should be nurtured at home. 
